Video: MiLB.tv • Audio: RidersBaseball.com, Tuneln Radio and MiLB First Pitch App THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER: Behind three-RBI displays from both Scott Heineman (3-3) and Hunter Cole (2-4), the Riders knocked off Springfield 6-3 Sunday afternoon in the series opener. Heineman went deep in the third and drew a bases-loaded walk, while Cole plated a pair with a two-run single in the Riders three-run fourth inning. He added an RBI single in the eighth. Riders starter Pedro Payano turned in the club's first quality start of the season, allowing three runs on seven hits in six innings.

HEINEMAN HEATING UP: Outfielder Scott Heineman went 0-4 in the season opener but has been on a tear ever since.

- The second-year Riders outfielder is 6-10 in his last three games with six RBls.
- Heineman already has two three-RBI games this season (also Friday vs. Tulsa) after recording just three in 117 contests last year.
- His six RBIs rank third-best in the Texas League entering play today.
- The native of Pacific Palisades, CA was a non-roster invitee to Rangers Spring Training this year, his first time in big league camp.

READY IN RELIEF: The Riders bullpen logged three more scoreless innings yesterday, continuing a red-hot stretch to begin the new season.

- The unit has a collective 1.10 ERA (2 ER in $161 / 3 \mathrm{IP}$ ) through the first four games, tops in the Texas League.
- Relievers have racked up 25 of their 49 outs via strikeout so far in 2018.

ENTER BRETT MARTIN: Lefty Brett Martin is set to make his Double-A debut tonight.

- Martin is the highest-rated prospect on the Riders Opening Day roster, ranked 15 th by MLB Pipeline and 18 th by Baseball America.
- He was one of six Rangers farmhands added to the 40-man roster this past offseason.
- Martin is seeking his first fully healthy season since his debut campaign in 2014. He has spent a combined 129 days on the DL in the last three years (more on page two).
- The southpaw is the fourth and final pitcher from the Opening Day roster set to make his Double-A debut. He's looking to follow in the footsteps of his other three teammates who made a strong first impression.

ELECTRIC START FOR COLE: Outfielder Hunter Cole is off to a fantastic start in 2018, hitting . 400 (6-15) through his first four games.

- Cole has three two-hit games already through his first four contests. He had 19 in 83 games last year with Double-A Richmond (San Francisco).
- Yesterday's three-RBI game was his first since September 1, 2016.
- He homered in his first at-bat of 2018 Thursday vs. Tulsa, his third consecutive $A B$ with a long ball dating back to his final two trips to the plate in 2017.
- The 25 -year-old was acquired by the Rangers November 15 as the player-to-be-named later in a deal for Sam Dyson.

SURGE OF STRIKEOUTS: Riders pitchers have accumulated 43 strikeouts through the season's first four games,
second-most in the Texas League (San Antonio, 48) and tied for 12 th-best among the 120 full-season teams in Minor League Baseball.

## 2017 SEASON

- Enters 2018 as the Rangers 15th-best prospect in the eyes of MLB Pipeline and is ranked 18th by Baseball America.
- Pitched all year with Advanced-A Down East, helping the Wood Ducks to a Carolina League co-championship.
- Struck out a career-high 10 batters May 6 vs. Wilmington.
- Placed on the DL following that start with a right abdominal strain and was out nearly two months.
- Turned in a season-best seven innings and allowed two runs on three hits with eight strikeouts in his penultimate start of the season, August 26 vs. Lynchburg.
- Struck out seven batters or more in five of his 16 starts.
- Walked at least one batter in each of his 16 starts with three-or-more free passes in six (season/career-high five walks August 19 vs. Buies Creek).
- Made 10 of his 16 starts at home and had a noticeably lower ERA at Grainger Stadium (3.76) than on the road (6.25).


## CAREER NOTES

- Is one of seven Rangers farmhands to win a championship ring each of the last three season (2015-Class-A Hickory, 2016 - Advanced-A High Desert, 2017 - Advanced-A Buies Creek).
- Has been on the DL for significant stints each of the last three years, totaling 129 days on the shelf.
$>2015$ : left knee strain (8/1-8/8) and right hip strain (8/29-9/14)
$>2016$ : left elbow strain (6/6-8/8)
> 2017: right adominal strain (5/12-6/28)
- Turned in the best start of his career in game two of the 2016 California League Championship Series vs. Visalia, dealing seven no-hit innings while recording 15 strikeouts.
- Named a 2015 South Atlantic League Midseason All-Star with Class-A Hickory.
- Grew up near Knoxville, TN and is a huge Tennessee Volunteers fan. Originally attended UT before transferring to Walters State Community College (in his hometown of Morristown) before spring of his FR year.
- While at Walters St., played w/ current Rays farmhand Brent Honeywell.
