DINGERS CARRY SPRINGFIELD TO SWEEP: The Springfield Cardinals hit four homers - coming in two sets of back-to-back roundtrippers - to claim the series finale 7-5 Tuesday at Hammons Field. The Cardinals hit their first two homers in the second and the other two in a four-run seventh, erasing a 4-3 deficit to jump in front 7-4. The Riders got big performances from Michael De Leon (3-for-3, walk, RBI, two runs) and Michael O'Neill ( 2 -for-3, two walks, RBI, run) in the defeat.

EMPTY WIN COLUMN ON THE ROAD: The Riders finished the season's opening road trip $0-6$, marking the first time they've gone winless on a multi-series road trip/homestand since August 23-28, 2016, when they went 0-6 in San Antonio and Midland.

LONG BALL LAUNCH: After allowing four home runs in the first six games at home, Riders pitching surrendered 15 dingers in the six games at Tulsa and Springfield last week.

- Riders hurlers gave up three-or-more homers in three of the six games.
- Frisco arms gave up three sets of back-to-back homers on the road trip and have allowed four clusters of back-to-back jacks already this year.
- Through 12 games this year, Frisco pitching has yielded 19 long balls, second-most in the Texas League (Midland, 21).
- Last year's staff set a new franchise record for most homers allowed in a season (146). This year's group is on a pace to surrender 222 roundtrippers. The Texas League single-season record is 178 (Arkansas, 2006).

INTRODUCING HIMSELF WITH AUTHORITY: Outfielder Hunter Cole has made a strong first impression on the Rangers in his first year as a member of the farm system.

- Cole enters play today leading the league in average (.405), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.522) and tied for third in walks (9). He has been intentionally walked twice, the only player in the Texas League to be purposely passed over more than once.
- The righty swinger had his seven-game hitting streak curtailed Tuesday in Springfield but has still reached safely in eight consecutive games.
- Through 11 games, Cole already has six two-hit performances for the Riders.
- Cole is in his first year with the Rangers organization after playing the first four years of his pro career in the Giants system. He was traded to the Rangers in November as the player-to-be-named-later in a deal for Sam Dyson.

NOT QUITE BASEBALL WEATHER: In a nine-game stretch between April 7 and April 16, the Riders played in the four coldest contests in recorded franchise history.

This stretch marks the coldest games since a 42-degree start at Arkansas April 14, 2014. Between 2015 and 2017, the Riders hadn't started in conditions cooler than 57 degrees.

ON THE MEND: Rangers outfielder Delino Deshields is scheduled to join the Riders tonight to begin a rehab assignment. - Deshields went on the DL March 31 with a fractured hamate bone in his left hand.

- This is his first time suiting up for the Riders. However, he has previous Texas League experience, having played for the Hooks in 2014. He was a Midseason All-Star that season for Corpus Christi, batting .236 with 11 home runs and 57 RBIs.
