ELEVEN-RUN OUTBURST SINKS RIDERS: Trailing 1-0 after four innings Friday, the RoughRiders allowed 10 runs in the final five innings and dropped a 11-3 decision to the Corpus Christi Hooks at Dr Pepper Ballpark. Corpus Christi took control of the game with a five-run fifth inning, chasing starter Wes Benjamin from the game. The Riders got their three runs on one swing of the bat, when Hunter Cole went deep in the sixth. Delino Deshields went 2-for-3 with a run in his second rehab game with Frisco.

INGRATIATING HIMSELF IN A NEW SYSTEM: Outfielder Hunter Cole continues to pace Riders hitters, highlighted by his three-run homer in Friday's loss to Corpus Christi.

- Cole enters play leading the team in average (.378), on-base percentage (.491), slugging (.533), hits (17), home runs (2), RBIs (10) and is tied for the top spot in walks (11).
- His average ranks third-best in the Texas League and his OBP is good for fourth. He is also the only player in the league to garner multiple intentional walks this season.
- Through his first 13 games, Cole has hit safely in 11 . He's been aboard safely in 12 of 13 and 10 straight entering play tonight.
- Cole is in his first year as a Rangers farmhand after coming over from the Giants organization in November as the player-to-be-named-later in last June's deal for Sam Dyson.

GOLD GLOVER FOR A REASON: Riders catcher Jose Trevino was presented with his 2017 Rawlings Minor League Gold Glove Award prior to Friday's game and proceeded to throw out two runners trying to advance to second base in the same inning.

- Last year with the Riders, Trevino made just three errors in 99 games, threw out $41 \%$ of attempted base stealers, picked off four runners and only allowed three passed balls.
- This is his second consecutive Gold Glove after winning the honor in 2016 with Advanced-A High Desert.
- Trevino is the 19th player in Minor League Baseball history to win the award twice. Only four players have done it three times (the award has been in existence from 1957-1984 and 2011-present).

HALT THE STREAK: The Riders enter play tonight on a eight-game losing streak.

- It's their longest since a streak of the same length August 23-31, 2016.
- A loss tonight would establish the longest skid since an 11-gamer in 2015.
- The franchise record is 13 games (July 3-16, 2005).

TRENDING BACK TOWARD FULL HEALTH: Rangers outfielder Delino Deshields is scheduled to continue a rehab assignment with the Riders tonight after going 3-for-6 with a pair of bunt singles the last two days.

- Deshields went on the DL March 31 with a fractured hamate bone in his left hand. He had played just two games for the Rangers prior to hitting the shelf.
- This is his first time suiting up for the Riders. However, he has previous Texas League experience, having played for the Hooks in 2014. He was a Midseason All-Star that season for Corpus Christi, batting . 236 with 11 home runs and 57 RBIs.

## 2018 SEASON

- Last start (Saturday at Tulsa): Had 10 baserunners reach against him ( $6 \mathrm{H}, 2 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{E}$ ) but only permitted two unearned runs in $42 / 3$ innings.
- Turned in a quality start in his first outing of the year, earning the win against Springfield April 8.


## 2017 SEASON

- Spent the first two months of the season with Advanced-A Down East before making his Double-A debut with the Riders June 1.
- Went at least five innings in each of his final eight outings (3x first nine games), logging three quality starts.
- Named Carolina League Pitcher of the Week (5/15-5/21) after combining to allow one earned run on four hits across two starts.
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 25 hit batters across two levels. Hit at least one batter in 11 of his 17 appearances with the Riders and did it once with Down East.
- Prior to 2017, had never hit more than eight batters in a season.
- Fell one shy of a career-high with 10 strikeouts across $61 / 3$ innings August 4 vs. Corpus Christi.


## CAREER NOTES

- Named a South Atlantic League Midseason All-Star with Class-A Hickory in 2016.
- Turned in one of the best starts of his career $4 / 27 / 16$, dealing a complete-game, one-hit shutout against Greensboro.
- Went on the DL 7/9/16 and missed the remainder of the season with a fractured forearm after getting hit by a comebacker.
- Named Rangers Minor League Pitcher of the Month twice in 2015 (June and July).
- Born in New York, NY but moved to the Dominican Republic shortly after birth.
