 ICED OUT LATE: The Riders dropped Monday's game against Springfield by a final of 4-3. The Frisco bats came out swinging early, scoring three times in the second inning to take a quick 3-0 lead. Scott Heineman highlighted the frame with a two-run double. Springfield answered with two in the third and took the lead with another pair in the fifth. After the Riders loaded the bases with nobody out to start the sixth, Springfield relievers Landon Beck and Chris Ellis retired the final 12 men they faced - stirking out seven - to seal the victory and force a rubber match tonight.

FLYING HIGH-NEMAN: Outfielder Scott Heineman went 0-4 in the season opener but has been on a tear ever since.

- The second-year Riders outfielder is 5-6 with five RBIs in the first two games of this series and is 8-13 on his current four-game hitting streak.
- Heineman already has two three-RBI games this season (Friday vs. Tulsa and Sunday vs. Springfield) after recording just three in 117 contests last year.
- His eight RBIs rank third-best in the Texas League entering play today.
- The native of Pacific Palisades, CA was a non-roster invitee to Rangers Spring Training this year, his first time in big league camp.

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Riders bullpen logged four more scoreless innings last night, continuing a red-hot stretch to begin the new season.

The unit has a collective 0.89 ERA (2 ER in $201 / 3$ IP) through the first five games, tops in the Texas League.

- The pen enters play tonight with a nine-inning scoreless streak, dating back to Saturday against Tulsa.
- Relievers have racked up 27 of their 61 outs via strikeout so far in 2018.

ELUSIVE STREAKS: The Riders have started the season alternating wins and losses through each of the first five games. Last year's club was also immune to long streaks, with no winning streak longer than four games and no losing skid longer than six.

XFERS COMING ON STRONG: Three members of the Riders roster are new to the Rangers organization this year and all three have made strong first impressions on their new system.

- Eliezer Alvarez (2017 with St. Louis system): Has reached base safely in four of his first five games, all while adapting to the outfield for the first time in his career.
- Hunter Cole (2017 with San Francisco system): Hit safely in four of his first five games, with multiple hits in three of those outings.
- Tommy Joseph (2017 with Philadelphia system): Hit safely in four of his first five games and leads the team with two doubles.

## 2017 SEASON

- Pitched most of the year with Advanced-A Down East before joining the Riders in early August.

- Ended the year with 10 wins across two levels, tied for most in the organization with teammate Wes Benjamin.

- Had a 17-inning scoreless streak toward the end of the season, which expired in his final start of the campaign.
- Fired the first and only nine-inning game of his career May 26 at Win-ston-Salem.
