**LAST TIME OUT:** Daytona captured the rubber match against Florida on Wednesday afternoon, as the Tortugas bested the Fire Frogs, 5-4, in front of 1,855 fans at Jackie Robinson Ballpark...Tied at 2, Daytona grabbed the lead for good in the 5th inning with a 3-run frame...RF **Andy Sugilio** (2-4, 2 R, 2B, RBI, 2 SO) put the Tugass ahead with an RBI double to left-center...C **Mark Kolozsvary** (2-4, R, HR, RBI, SO) collected 2 hits and a solo home run in the 2nd inning...CF **Stuart Fairchild** (2-4, RBI) also added a multi-hit game for Daytona...RF **Trey Harris** (2-5, R, 2B, HR, 3 RBI, SO) clocked a two-run blast to center for Florida in the 4th...SS **Riley Delgado** (2-5, R, RBI, SO) and DH **Drew Luggbauer** (2-4, SO) each posted multiple knocks for the Fire Frogs...RHP **Diomar López** (2.0 IP, H, 4 SO) struck out a season-high 4 to earn his 2nd win of the season...LHP **Andy Cox** (1.0 IP, H) hurled a scoreless 9th to garner save number 5...LHP **Philip Pfeifer** (5.0 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 2 BB, 2 SO) took his 4th defeat of the year for Florida...Daytona's RHP **Mac Sceroler** (4.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 5 SO) retired the first 9 hitters he faced, but was saddled with a no-decision.

**TONIGHT'S THRESHERS STARTER:** Clearwater is scheduled to give the ball to RHP **Julian García** in Thursday's lid-lifter...The 24-year-old earned his 5th win of the season last Wednesday night vs. St. Lucie (6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 4 BB, 5 SO)...Collected a no-decision in his lone start against Daytona on May 4 at Spectrum Field (4.2 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 3 BB, 4 SO)...Since then holds a 4-2 record with a 2.78 ERA (11 ER in 35.2 IP) and 34 strikeouts in 6 starts...Has been much more effective on the road than at home in 2019...At Spectrum Field, García has posted a 1-3 clip with a 4.94 ERA (15 ER in 27.1 IP) in 5 starts...As a visitor, the right-hander holds a 4-1 mark with a 1.65 ERA (6 ER in 32.2 IP) and 38 punchouts in 6 outings...Spent all of last season with Low-A Lakewood...Collected a 7-3 record with a 2.54 ERA (22 ER in 78.0 IP) and one save in 28 appearances (eight starts) for the BlueClaws...Selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the 10th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the Metropolitan State University of Denver...Signed for \$80,000.

**SCOOTING ALONG:** 2018 National League All-Star 2B **Scotter Gennett** was added to Daytona's roster on Monday as a part of a Major League rehab assignment...The 29-year-old has been on the Cincinnati Reds' injured list since March 28 with a right groin strain suffering in a spring training game on March 22...Gennett appeared in Monday's 6-4 win over the Florida Fire Frogs, batting 2nd and playing 2nd base...The left-handed hitter went 0-for-2 at the plate with a fly out to center, a ground out to second, and a 4-pitch walk...Gennett also fielded two ground balls, including starting a double play in the 5th...IF **Yonathan Mendoza** took over for Gennett after 5 innings, as scheduled...The Parrish, Fla. resident did not appear on Tuesday or Wednesday...Gennett was in the team's lineup on Tuesday, but was scratched due to inclement weather...Wednesday was a scheduled off day for the infielder...In 154 games with Cincinnati in 2018, Gennett recorded a .310 average (181-584) with 86 runs scored, 56 extra-base hits, 23 home runs, and 92 RBI...The Ohio native was the NL's Player of the Month for May, chosen as the league's Player of the Week twice, and received the team's MLBPA Heart and Hustle Award...Gennett played in the Florida State League as a Brewers' prospect in 2011 with the Brevard County Manatees...He registered a .300 mark (167-556) with 74 runs scored, 35 extra-base knocks, 9 home runs, and 51 RBI in 134 contests en route to being named an FSL Mid-Season and Postseason All-Star...He also appeared in 2 games on rehab with Brevard County in 2016, going 2-for-6...In his career, Gennett is a .258 hitter (17-66) with 9 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 homers, and 6 RBI in 18 games against the Threshers.

**GET RUBBERY:** The Tortugas snapped a remarkable cold streak in rubber matches on Wednesday afternoon...After losing 5-straight rubber matches and 16-of-17 dating back to May 3, 2018, at Jupiter, Daytona squeaked past Florida, 5-4, at Jackie Robinson Ballpark...In 6 series-deciding games, Daytona has only been outscored by a total of 21-14 with 5 one-run games (1-4)...Despite a stellar overall season in 2018, Daytona struggled mightily in rubber matches, accruing a 3-12 record in those affairs...Prior to Wednesday's triumph, the Tugass had not won a series-deciding game in the regular season since a 5-1 win at Dunedin on April 22, 2018...Daytona had previously won a rubber match, 5-3, in Game 3 of the North Division Championship Series on September 6, 2018, vs. Clearwater at Jackie Robinson Ballpark.

**FRESH START:** After missing out on clinching a playoff berth in the first half, the Tortugas will begin a new push to the postseason, as the second half got underway on Monday evening...With the All-Star Game serving as the halfway point for the Florida State League in 2019, Daytona will play 73 games in the season's second leg...38 of those contests will be at Jackie Robinson Ballpark and 35 will be in visiting ballparks...In 5 years since the rebrand, the Tortugas have mustered a winning record in the first half in each season (178-157)...The organization has not had a losing first half since the Daytona Cubs went 26-42 in the first half of 2014...Comparatively, the Tugass have not had a winning second half since they accumulated a 40-28 record, while finishing in 3rd place in the North in 2016...In the last 2 years, Daytona has gone 52-85 in the second half (.380)...Since becoming the Tortugas in 2015, Daytona has not won an outright second half title...In 2015, the team clinched a wild card berth in the second half as a result of holding the second-best overall record in the North Division after Clearwater won both halves...Daytona has not won a second-half crown outright since the 2014 Daytona Cubs did it with a 41-27 record.

**ANDY'S ALWAYS ON:** OF **Andy Sugilio** has been red hot for Daytona lately...The 22-year-old had a season-high 9-game hitting streak snapped on Tuesday, but has recorded knocks in 10-of-his-last-11 contests and multiple hits in 7-of-8 affairs...Dating back to June 4, Sugilio has collected a .400 average (18-45) with 9 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 4 runs batted in, and 4 stolen bases...The switch-hitter has slashed a .400/.426/.489 line with a .915 OPS and a .514 BABIP...In his last 8 contests, the Dominican native has tallied a 15-for-35 clip at the plate (.429 AVG) with 2 doubles and 3 RBI...As Daytona's leadoff hitter, Sugilio has posted a .351 average (13-37) in 9 games...Sugilio's previous season-high was an 8-game hitting streak from April 26-May 7...During that run, the FSL Mid-Season All-Star batted .406 (13-32) with 5 runs scored and 5 runs batted in.

**IT'S STU SEASON:** OF **Stuart Fairchild** has found his stroke at the plate since coming back from a slight hamstring injury on May 4...In 34 games since missing a week of action, the 23-year-old has compiled a .320 average (41-128) with 19 runs scored, 12 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 28 runs batted in, 2 stolen bases, 13 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches...During the run, Fairchild has slashed .320/.393/.547 with a .940 OPS...Over his last 35 games – going back to April 27 vs. Bradenton – the Seattle, Wash. native has reached base in 31-of-35 contests and picked up a base-hit in 26 of those affairs...In his first 14 games, Fairchild was slashing .113/.175/.151 with a 6-for-53 ledger at the dish...In 35 affairs since, he is slashing .326/.401/.550 with 18 extra-base hits and raised his batting average 151 points from .113 to .264.

**LIVIN' LA VIDA LÓPEZ:** 2B **Alejo López** has been a key part of Daytona's offense all season long...On Monday night, the 23-year-old had his Florida State League season-high 22-game on-base streak snapped...During the stretch from May 17-June 12, López accumulated a .305 average (25-82) with 12 runs scored, 5 doubles, 8 runs batted in, 7 walks, and a .376 OBP...The switch-hitter had an on-base streak of 14 games earlier in the campaign from April 9-24...During that run, López registered an impressive .357 average (20-56) with 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, 10 RBI, 2 walks, and 2 hit-by-pitches...The Phoenix, Ariz. resident slashed .357/.400/.518 with a .918 OPS in that span...López surpassed teammate SS **José García** (20), as well as Tampa's **Diego Castillo** and Dunedin's **Cullen Large** for the longest on-base streak in the FSL this year.

**THE STARTING LINE:** After a rough start to May, Daytona's rotation turned a corner in the final week-plus of the month and carried it into June...Over the last 30 games, the Tortugas' starting pitchers have accumulated just a 5-10 record, but maintain a sparkling 2.71 ERA (47 ER in 156.0 IP)...During that span, Daytona's starters have accrued 140 hits allowed, 139 strikeouts and just 32 walks...The Tortugas hold a 17-13 clip during those 30 games...The run has also featured a four-game stretch (May 22-25) where Daytona starters did not issue an earned run...The Tortugas went just 2-2 in those games, but tallied 23-straight frames without yielding an ERA-increasing tally...Daytona has also posted 10 quality starts during the stretch...Prior to this recent collection of starts, the Tugass starting staff had gone 4-5 with a 5.58 ERA (37 ER in 59.2 IP), 78 hits allowed, 13 walks, and 53 strikeouts in 13 games.

**NOT SO FRIENDLY CONFINES:** The Tortugas have put up better results in visiting ballparks than in their own in 2019...Entering Thursday, Daytona holds a 19-11 mark in games played in opposing stadiums...In affairs held at Jackie Robinson Ballpark, the Tortugas record drops to 18-20...In contests played as the road team, Daytona has a .258 team batting average (299-1158) with 143 runs scored (4.3/g), 75 extra-base hits (2.3/g), 13 home runs (0.4/g), as well as 95 walks (2.9/g)...At home, the Tortugas average dips by 25 points down to .233 (263-1127)...Additionally, the team has scored 134 runs (3.82/g), 85 extra-base hits (2.4/g), 21 home runs (0.6/g), and 97 walks (2.8/g)...On the mound, Daytona's team ERA is slightly better in their own ballpark (3.43), as opposed to visiting parks (3.57)...3B **Jonathan India** has been better on the road this season, too...The 22-year-old holds a .288 clip (34-118) with 18 runs scored, 10 extra-base knocks, 3 homers, and 9 RBI in 29 road games...At home, India is batting .235 (28-119) with 20 runs scored, 10 extra-base hits, 5 home runs, and 15 RBI in 34 games...C **Hendrick Clementina** has also thrived away from Daytona Beach...Entering Wednesday, he holds a .256 mark (22-86) with 3 homers and 12 RBI in 21 games on the road...At home, he is batting just .191 (18-94) with 2 long balls and 8 RBI in 27 affairs...OF **Andy Sugilio**'s batting average splits are also quite different...The 22-year-old is hitting .333 (38-114) away from The Jack and .267 (28-105) within its confines.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Collected his third win of the campaign last Wednesday evening at Lakeland...Issued one run on three hits in a season-high-tying six innings...Walked one and struck out one...Surrendered a solo home run to CF **Brock Deatherage** in the bottom of the first...Hurled 82 pitches and 54 strikes (65.9%)...Relieved by RHP **Julio Pinto** with Daytona leading, 4-1, in the bottom of the seventh...Tortugas hung on to defeat the Flying Tigers, 4-3.
