STREAK REACHES TWO IN 7-4 WIN: The Riders won consecutive games for the first time this year after knocking off Midland 7-4 Wednesday night in West Texas. After scoring two unearned runs in the third, the Riders blew the game open with a five-run fourth inning. Michael O'Neill led the way with three hits and Hunter Cole had three RBIs in the victory. Pedro Payano registered a quality start and Jeffrey Springs helped him get the win with a two-inning save.

TREVINO SCORCHING HOT: Since coming off the DL prior to Friday's game in San Antonio, catcher Jose Trevino has been a key contributor for the Riders at the plate.

- Trevino is 8 -for-17 in his first five games back with a triple, a homer and five RBIs. His average has increase from . 184 to .237 during this stretch.
- His triple Sunday was the sixth of his career and first since August 13, 2015 with Class-A Hickory.
- The 2017 Texas League Midseason and Postseason All-Star missed 11 games after going on the DL April 29 with a right quad injury.

RUNS COMING IN BULK: The Riders have scored 23 runs in the last four games as the bats continue to turn things around.
. By comparison, the squad scored 22 runs in the previous 10 games before this stretch.

- In these last four games, the Riders have scored at least four runs in an innings three times.
- The team is batting . 336 (49-for-146) in this stretch after swinging just .212 in the previous 10 games.

EXCELLENT PENMANSHIP: Riders relievers have been in a groove the last few weeks.

- Since giving up 16 runs out of the pen May 1, Riders relievers sport a 2.87 ERA (17 ER in $531 / 3$ IP) in the last 14 games. In the 18 games prior, that mark was 7.73 .
- During this stretch, opponents are hitting just . 176 (30-for-170) and have struck out 56 times.
- Reed Garrett hasn't allowed a run in $92 / 3$ innings since giving up three runs in his first outing with the club on May 1.
- Jeffrey Springs has gone $72 / 3$ innings without yielding a run and has retired 17 straight batters.
- The bullpen's torch bearer, Brady Feigl, was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock yesterday. He didn't permit a run in his $161 / 3$ innings of work with the Riders.

A GOOD TIME TO BE NAMED MICHAEL: Both Michaels on the roster are surging at the plate lately.

- Michael De Leon: Hitting . 333 on his current nine-game hitting streak (tied for the team's longest this year), raising his average from . 223 to .252 .
- Michael O'Neill: Hitting 421 on his current four-game hitting streak, raising his average from . 192 to .229. He has hit safely in eight of his last 11 games (13-for-47) in the wake of an 0 -for- 26 skid.

KEEPING THE BALL IN THE YARD: The Riders have only allowed one home run in the last eight games, improving on a tough start to the year in that statistical category.

- Prior to this stretch, Frisco hurlers went 10 straight games with at least one long ball ( 17 total home runs).
- Even with the recent improvements, Riders pitching leads the Texas League with 48 homers allowed. The group is on pace to allow 172 roundtrippers, which would surpass last year's franchise record of 146 and challenge the Texas League single-season record of 178 (Arkansas, 2006).
