COOLED OFF BY THE CARDS: The Riders fell 14-3 in the series opener at Springfield Sunday afternoon. After taking a 2-0 lead in the top of the first, the Riders allowed a five-run first to the Cardinals and never recovered. Springfield scored in
five of its eight innings at the plate and capped the day with a four-run eighth. Luis La $\mathbf{O}$ had two hits and two RBIs for the Riders in his Double-A debut.

HUNTER KEEPS HITTING: Outfielder Hunter Cole continued his fantastic start to 2018 Sunday, going 2-for-3 with a walk and an RBI single.

- He enters play today ranking third in the league with a .452 average.
- Cole has multiple hits in three straight games and six of his first nine contests overall to start 2018.
- The righty swinger is in his first year with the Rangers organization after playing the first four years of his pro career in the Giants system. He was traded to the Rangers in November as the player-to-be-named-later in a deal for Sam Dyson.

INTRODUCING LUIS: Infielder Luis La $\mathbf{O}$ made his Double-A debut in strong fashion Sunday, going 2-for-4 with a pair of RBIs.

- La O joined the Riders Saturday from Advanced-A Down East but had been on the Wood Ducks' DL all season.
- He is in his second season playing Minor League Baseball after spending the first six years of his professional career in Cuba's Serie Nacional. He accumulated a career . 329 average during his six seasons in Cuba, batting better than .300 in each of his final four campaigns.

LONG BALL LAUNCH: Riders pitchers have had trouble keeping the ball in the yard so far on this road trip.

- Through the first four games of this trip, the Riders have seen nine balls clear the fence, including three each of the last two games.
- All six homers hit the last two days have come in the sixth inning or later.
- Through 10 games this year, Frisco pitching has yielded 13 long balls, second-most in the Texas League (Midland, 18).
- Last year's staff set a new franchise record for most homers allowed in a season (146). This year's group is on a pace to surrender 182 roundtrippers.

LIVING IN LOW TEMPS: Yesterday's game-time temperature of 33 degrees marked the Riders third game this season (out of 10) to start in frigid conditions. Saturday's game in Tulsa began in 42 degree conditions and the Riders played in 41 degree temperatures April 7 vs. Tulsa at Dr Pepper Ballpark.

YEARNING FOR A WIN: After alternating wins and losses throughout the opening homestand, the Riders have started the season's first road trip 0-4. Last year, the Riders did a good job of limiting long skids though, never losing more than six in a row.
