LAST TIME OUT: The Tortugas came away with their 3rd-straight victory, as Daytona topped the Lakeland Flying Tigers, 4-3, on Wednesday, June 12, at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium...DH Alejo López (3-4, R, SO) picked up a game-high 3 hits, while LF Drew Mount (2-4, 2B, 2 RBI, 2 SO) drove in a pair...RF Andy Sugilio (2-5, SO) also added a multi-hit performance for the Tugas...CF Brock Deatherage (2-4, R, HR, 2 RBI) and RF Dylan Rosa (2-4, R, HR, RBI, SO) each posted 2 hits and blasted a solo home run for Lakeland...RHP Austin Orewiller (6.0 IP, 3 H, R, ER, BB, SO) gave up 1 run over 6 innings for a quality start and his 3rd win...RHP Ryan Nutof (1.0 IP, 3 SO) struck out the side in order in the 9th to collect his Florida State League-leading 9th save...RHP Garrett Hill (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 5 SO) issued 3 runs in 5 innings, suffering his 1st loss in the FSL.

TONIGHT'S FIRE FROGS STARTER: To begin the second half, RHP Matt Hartman is expected to make his 3rd Florida State League start of the season for Florida...The 23-year-old suffered the loss in his last start on Saturday, June 8, at Tampa (4,0 IP, 6 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 8B, 2 SO)...Transferred to Florida from Low-A Rome on June 7...Made 4 appearances (1 start) for the R-Braves, posting a 1-0 record with a 2.65 ERA (4 ER in 13.2 IP), 1 save, and 15 strikeouts... Initially joined the Fire Frogs' roster from extended spring training on April 30 and transferred to Rome on May 12...Threw 5 innings of scoreless relief for Florida on April 27 at St. Lucie (5.0 IP, H, 2 BB, 2 SO)...Spent his first pro season with Rookie Danville in 2018...Collected an 0-1 record with a 2.87 ERA (5 ER) in 15.2 IP) and 8 strikeouts in 5 starts for the D-Braves...Signed by the Atlanta Braves as an undrafted free agent on July 31, 2018 out of Westmont (Calif.) College...Transferred after spending his freshman and sophomore campaigns at the University of Arizona...Signed a year after graduating following Tommy John surgery.

FRESH START: After missing out on clinching a playoff berth in the first half, the Tortugas will begin a new push to the postseason, as the second half begins on Monday evening. With the All-Star Game serving as the halfway point for the Florida State League in 2019, Daytona will play 73 games in the season's second leg...38 of those contests will be at Jackie Robinson Ballbark and 35 will be in visiting ballparks...In five years since the rebrand, the Tortugas have mustered a winning record in the first half in each season (178-157)...The organization has not had a losing first half since the Daytona Cubs went 26-42 in the first half of 2014...Comparatively, the "Tugas have not had a winning second half since they accumulated a 40-28 record, while finishing in 3rd place in the North in 2016...In the last two years, Daytona has gone 52-85 in the second half (380)...Since becoming the Tortugas in 2015, Daytona has not won an outright second half title...In 2015, the team clinched a wild card berth in the second half as a result of holding the second-best overall record in the North Division after Clearwater won both halves...Daytona has not won a second-half crown outright since the 2014 Daytona Cubs did it with a 41-27 record.

SOMEONE CALL THE JANITOR: Daytona completed their 5th sweep of the 2019 campaign in a rain-abbreviated series against Lakeland (June 10-12) before the All-Star break...The Tortugas sweep a 3-game series from at Osceola County Stadium against the Florida Fire Frogs from April 18-20...They also took 3 contests from the Dunedin Blue Javs (April 22-24) and Lakeland Flying Tigers (May 9-11) at The Jack...Prior to last week, their most recent sweep came in Tampa against the Tarpons from May 17-19...Daytona had not swept a series in Lakeland since they won all 3 affairs from August 7-9, 2015...The franchise still has not taken all 4 contests in series at Joker Marchant Stadium since the Daytona Cubs did it from August 22-24, 2014...The Tortugas have not swept a 4-game series since they completed the feat from April 9-12 vs. Charlotte last season...Additionally, Daytona has not swept a 4-affair set on the road since they snatched every game at Jupiter from June 12-15, 2016.

SWEET SWINGIN' SUGILIO: OF Andy Sugilio has been red hot for Daytona over the last week...The 22-year-old enters Monday on a season-high-tying 8-game hitting streak...Dating back to June 4, Sugilio has collected a .412 average (14-34) with 5 runs scored, a double, a triple, 3 runs batted in, and 3 stolen bases...The switch-hitter is slashing a .412/412/5.00 line with a .912 OPS and 538 BABIP...Sugilio's also hit in 8-straight games from April 26-May 7...During that run, the Dominican native batted .406 (13-32) with 5 runs scored and 5 runs batted in.

LIVIN' LA VIDA LÓPEZ: 2B Alejo López has been a key part of Daytona's offense all season long...Entering Monday's contest, the 23-year-old is on a Florida State League season-high 22-game on-base streak dating back to May 17...During the streich, López has accumulated a .305 average (25-82) with 12 runs scored, 5 doubles, 8 runs batted in, 7 walks, and a .376 OBP...The switch-hitter had an on-base streak of 14 games earlier in the campaign from April 9-24...During that run, López registered an impressive .357 average (20-56) with 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, 10 RBI, 2 walks, and 2 hit-by-pitches...The Phoenix, Ariz. resident slashed .357/.400/.518 with a .918 OPS in that span...He has now surpassed teammate SS José Garcia (20), as well as Tampa's Diego Castillo and Dunedin's Cullen Large for the longest on-base streak in the FSL this year.

THE STARTING LINE: After a rough start to May, Daytona's rotation turned a corner in the final week-plus of the month and carried it into June...Over the last 27 games, the Tortugas' starting pitchers have accumulated just a 5-9 record, but maintain a sparkling 2.58 ERA (41 ER in 143.0 IP)...During that span, Daytona's starters have accrued 128 hits allowed, 124 strikeouts and just 30 walks...The Tortugas hold a 15-12 clip during those 27 games... The run has also featured a four-game stretch (May 22-25) where Daytona starters did not issue an earned run...The Tortugas went just 2-2 in those games, but tallied 23-straight frames without yielding an ERA-increasing tally...Daytona has also posted 10 quality starts during the run...Prior to this recent collection of starts, the Tugas starting staff had gone 4-5 with a 5.58 ERA (37 ER in 59.2 IP), 78 hits allowed, 13 walks, and 53 strikeouts in 13 games.

MY FAIR CHILD: OF Stuart Fairchild has found his stroke at the plate since coming back from a slight hamstring injury on May 4...In 31 games since missing a week of action, the 23-year-old has compiled a .316 average (37-117) with 18 runs scored, 10 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 25 runs batted in, 2 stolen bases, 13 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches. During the run, Fairchild has slashed .316/.396/.547 with a .943 OPS...Over his last 32 games – going back to April 27 vs. Bradenton – the Seattle, Wash. native has reached base in 29-of-32 ontests and picked up a base-hit in 24 of those affairs...In his first 14 games, Fairchild was slashing .113/.175/.151 with a 6-for-53 ledger at the dish...In 32 affairs since, he is slashing .322/.404/.551 with 16 extra-base hits and raised his batting average 144 points from .113 to .257.

FLYING HIGH: During Tuesday evening's 9-4 victory over Lakeland, Daytona's offense collected several high-water marks for the 2019 season...The Tortugas set a season-best for runs and hits in a single frame, scoring 7 times on 7 hits during the 2nd inning...Daytona's previous season-best came when they scored 6 runs in a single-frame on two occassions...The Tugas scratches in the 4th inning vs. Lakeland on May 11 and in the 5th vs. Palm Beach on May 6...The 7 knocks in an inning overtook their previous high of 6, which was done two times...Daytona had 6 hits in the 5th on May 6 vs. Palm Beach and in the 2nd on May 3 at ClearWater...The 7 hits in a single inning is the most by Daytona since they had 7 hits in the 6th inning in a 12-8 win vs. Palm Beach on August 11, 2017...The 7 runs in a half-inning were the most by the Tugas in a single frame since they scored 8 runs in the 5th inning during a 14-3 win at Jupiter on April 27, 2017...Additionally, Daytona added 5 doubles, matching a previous season-high from June 1 at Jupiter and game two of a doubleheader on May 20 vs. Clearwater...The 16 team hits matched most in a single-game in 2019...The Tortugas also racked up 16 knocks on May 6 vs. Palm Beach.

NOT SO FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Tortugas have put up better results in visiting ballparks than in their own in 2019...Entering Thursday, Daytona holds a 19-11 mark in games played in opposing stadiums...In affairs held at Jackie Robinson Ballpark, the Tortugas record drops to 16-19...In contests played as the road team. Daytona has a 258 team batting average (299-1158) with 143 runs scored. (4,31q), 75 extra-base hits (2,31g), 13 home runs (0.4/g), as well as 95 walks (2,9/g)...At home, the Tortugas average dips by 23 points down to .235 (243-1036)...Additionally, the team has scored 123 runs (3.84/g), 78 extra-base hits (2.4/g), 20 home runs (0.6/g), and 87 walks (2.7/g)...On the mound, Daytona's team ERA is slightly better in their own ballpark (3.41), as opposed to visiting parks (3.57)...3B Jonathan India has been better on the road this season, too...The 22-year-old holds a .286 clip (34-118) with 18 runs scored, 10 extra-base hits, 5 home runs, and 15 RBI in 31 games...C Hendrik Clementina has also thrived away from Daytona Beach...Entering Thursday, he holds a .256 mark (22-86) with 3 homers and 12 RBI in 21 games on the road...At home, he is batting just .182 (16-88) with 2 long balls and 7 RBI in 25 faffairs...OF Andy Sugilio's batting average splits are also quite different...The 22-year-old is hitting .333 (38-114) away from The Jack and .255 (24-94) within its confines.

BOYS GO TO JUPITER: The Florida State League announced their Mid-Season All-Star teams on Friday morning...The Tortugas had five players selected to the mid-summer festivities...C Hendrik Clementina (0-1), 3B Jonathan India (0-2; 2nd), 2B Alejo Lopez (0-2, SO; 7th), LHP Packy Naughton (DNP), and RHP Ryan Nutof (DNP) were the honorees...A sixth was added after the initial release, as OF Andy Sugilio (0-2, SO) will replace Lakelands Luke Burch...RHP Julio Pinto (1.0 IP) was added as a seventh player, replacing Nutof who was promoted to Double-A...Daytona is tied with the Clearwater Threshers for the most players represented on the North Division squad (7)...The Fort Myers Miracle had the most players chosen to the contest with 8...India, Lopez, Nutof, Pinto, and Sugilio were selected as Mid-Season All-Stars for the first time in their careers...India is in his 2nd pro season, Lopez is in his 5th, Nutof his 3rd, Sugilio fis 6th, and Pinto his 7th...Naughton had previously been chosen as a Mid-Season All-Star with Rookie Billings in the Pioneer League in 2017...Clementina made the Pioneer League Mid-Season All-Star squad in 2017 with Rookie Ogden and then again in the Midwest League with Low-A Dayton in 2018...Last season, the Tortugas had 8 players chosen to the contest: RHPs Ryan Hendrix, Joel Kuhnel, and Tony Santillan, as well as C Tyler Stephenson, 2B Brantley Bell, 3B Mitch Nay, and OFs T.J. Friedl and Taylor Trammell...The 2019 FSL All-Star Game will be held on Saturday, June 15, at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium in Jupiter.
