TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a ten-game homestand at Trustmark Park on Thursday Night with game four of a five-game series (1-2) against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos (MIN). The M-Braves swept Jacksonville in the first leg and are 6-2 during the homestand. Atlanta Braves No. 3 overall prospect RHP lan Anderson makes his team-leading seventh start on Thursday, and is opposed by RHP Randy Dobnak. Anderson is 5th in the Southern League with 37 strikeouts and ranks T-4th in Opp. AVG at . 181

M This series marks the first meeting with Pensacola serving as the Double-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. Since the Twins Double-A affiliate entered the Southern League, the Braves are 27-16 against them. The M-Braves will play 23 games against the Wahoos this season, including a return trip to Pensacola in the first half, May 28-June 1.

MAY ON THE MOUND: The M-Braves are 6-2 to begin the month of May , posting a 1.23 ERA (10 ER/73.0 IP) with 71 strikeouts, 23 walks and a .192 opponents batting average.

LAST TIME OUT: The M-Braves and Blue Wahoos combined to go 3 -for-27 with RISP and stranded 20 runners on base in the Wednesday morning contest won by Pensacola, 1-0. Mississippi stranded multiple runners on base in three of the final four innings. LF Drew Waters logged his seventh three-hit game of 2019, going 3 -for-5 with a pair of doubles. LHP Tucker Davidson suffered the loss allowing just one run on six hits over 5.0 innings, 3 walks and 7 strikeouts.

KEEP IT CLOSE: The M-Braves are now 14-6 in games decided by two-or-fewer runs this season.
WATERS SETTING THE TABLE: OF Drew Waters is batting .472 (17-for-36) over his last nine games since April 29, with a home run, five doubles, three RBI and seven runs scored.

M Waters leads the Southern League in batting (.349), doubles (14), XBH (18), total bases (69), T-1st in hits (44), 2nd in OPS (.931) and slugging (.548), T-2nd in runs (21) and 6th in OBP (.383).

PACHE BY THE NUMBERS: OF Cristian Pache has reached base safely in 11 straight games, batting .375 (15-for-40) with six multi-hit games, three doubles, a triple, home run, five RBI, four walks and four runs scored.

M Pache leads the Southern League in triples (4), is 2nd in total bases (61), T-2nd in XBH (15), 3rd in OPS (.906). slugging (.540) and hits (36), 4th in batting (.319), 4th in doubles (8) and 5th in RBI (19).

TOP TWO PITCHING TEAMS: This series matches the top two teams in the Southern League in pitching. Pensacola has a team-ERA of 2.41 , while the M-Braves boast a 2.93 ERA.

FIVE-GAME SERIES SWEEP: The M-Braves swept a five-game series from Jacksonville, May 1-5, just the fourth, five-game sweep in club history. The Southern League went to the five-game series format in 2008, the last came Aug. 22-26, 2014 vs. Birmingham. M-Braves' pitchers held the Shrimp to just three runs over 46 innings, with 49 strikeouts, holding them to a .173 batting average.

DON'T LET THE NAME FOOL YA: RHP Jeremy Walker has gone $4+$ innings in all six of his relief appearances behind Patrick Weigel and has allowed just nine earned runs in 31.0 IP with just two walks and 26 strikeouts. He ranks 9th in the league in ERA (2.63) and 10th in WHIP (1.06).

THIRD-MOST TALENTED TEAM IN MILB: MLB Pipeline ranked all 120 full season Minor League teams to open the season and the M-Braves roster ranked as the No. 3 most talented team in MiLB. Triple-A Gwinnett was ranked fifth

- Anderson enters today's start having not allowed a run over his last two starts and 12 innings. He ranks T-4th in the league in Opp. AVG (.181) and 5th in the league in strikeouts (37).
- Anderson is one of four 2016 draft picks in the M-Braves starting rotation (Muller/ Wentz/Davidson)

- The freshly turned 21 -year-old matched a career high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 shutout innings on two hits, walking three, earning his second-straight quality start and win on the mound. Anderson, Jason Hursh and Josh Graham combined for the two-hit shutout, 2-0 over Jacksonville.
