LAST TIME OUT: Daytona earned their fourth-straight victory on Monday night, opening the second half with a 6-4 win over the Florida Fire Frogs in front of 2,674 fans at Jackie Robinson Ballpark...The Tortugas broke it open in the 3rd inning on back-to-back 2-run doubles by CF **Stuart Fairchild** (2-4, R, 2 BB, 2 RBI) and 1B **Bruce Yari** (1-2, R, 2B, 2 RBI, 2 BB, SO)...RF **Andy Sugilio** (2-3, 2R, BB) reached base 4 times on 2 infield singles, a walk, and a hit-by-pitch...C **Hendrik Clementina** (2-4, 2B, RBI, 2 SO) added a pair of knocks, as well...1B **Drew Luga** (2-4, R, HR, RBI, SO) led Florida's offense with a team-best two hits, including a solo home run in the 8th...3B **Kevin Josephina** (1-3, R, HR, RBI, BB) added a solo home run to right-center in the 7th...RHP **Clate Schmidt** (1-2, IP, H, 2 R, ER, 2 BB, 4 SO) struck out a season-high 4 en route to his first win in the Reds' organization...LHP **Andy Cox** (1-0, IP, BB, 3 SO) struck out the side in the 9th to earn his 4th save in Daytona...Florida's RHP **Matt Hartman** (5-0, IP, 5 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 4 SO) suffered his 2nd defeat...RHP **Ryan Lillie** (4-0+, IP, 2 H, 3 SO) took a no-decision after exiting with an apparent hand injury with 1 on and nobody out in the top of the 5th.

TONIGHT'S FIRE FROGS STARTER: Florida is expected to hand the ball to RHP **Nolan Kingham** for game two of the series on Tuesday night...Suffered his second-straight defeat last Tuesday afternoon in game one of a doubleheader vs. Dunedin (6.1 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, BB, 3 SO)...Suffered the loss vs. Daytona in his Florida State League debut in game one of a twinbill on April 20 (4.1 IP, 9 H, 3 R, 3 ER, BB, 5 SO)...Has thrown 2 complete game shutouts on May 1 vs. Lakeland (9.0 IP, 3 H, 5 SO) and May 31 vs. Palm Beach (9.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 4 SO)...The 22-year-old has struggled mightily away from Kissimmee...In 5 home starts, holds a 2-2 record with a 2.76 ERA (10 ER in 32.2 IP) and 20 K's...Has posted a 1-3 clip and a 8.17 ERA (23 ER in 25.1 IP) with 18 punchouts in 5 road starts...Transferred to Florida from Low-A Rome on April 19...In 3 starts with the R-Braves, Kingham collected a 1-1 record with a 0.56 ERA (1 ER in 16.0 IP) and seven strikeouts...Selected by the Atlanta Braves in the 12th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of Texas...Signed for \$150,000...Selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 39th round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of Desert Oasis High School (Enterprise, Nev.), but did not sign...Older brother, Nick, is a pitcher for the Toronto Blue Jays.

FRESH START: After missing out on clinching a playoff berth in the first half, the Tortugas will begin a new push to the postseason, as the second half got underway on Monday evening...With the All-Star Game serving as the halfway point for the Florida State League in 2019, Daytona will play 73 games in the season's second leg...38 of those contests will be at Jackie Robinson Ballpark and 35 will be in visiting ballparks...In 5 years since the rebrand, the Tortugas have mustered a winning record in the first half in each season (178-157)...The organization has not had a losing first half since the Daytona Cubs went 26-42 in the first half of 2014...Comparatively, the 'Tugas have not had a winning second half since they accumulated a 40-28 record, while finishing in 3rd place in the North in 2016...In the last 2 years, Daytona has gone 52-85 in the second half (.380)...Since becoming the Tortugas in 2015, Daytona has not won an outright second half title...In 2015, the team clinched a wild card berth in the second half as a result of holding the second-best overall record in the North Division after Clearwater won both halves...Daytona has not won a second-half crown outright since the 2014 Daytona Cubs did it with a 41-27 record.

ANDY'S ALWAYS ON: OF **Andy Sugilio** has been red hot for Daytona lately...The 22-year-old enters Tuesday on a season-high 9-game hitting streak...Dating back to June 4, Sugilio has collected a .432 average (16-37) with 7 runs scored, a double, a triple, 3 runs batted in, and 4 stolen bases...The switch-hitter is slashing a .432/.462/.514 line with a .975 OPS and .552 BABIP...Going back to June 7, the switch-hitter has accumulated 6-consecutive multi-hit games...In those affairs, the Dominican native is 13-for-27 at the plate (.481 AVG) with a double and 2 RBI...As Daytona's leadoff hitter, Sugilio has posted a .379 average (11-29) in 7 games...Sugilio's previous season-high was an 8-game hitting streak from April 26-May 7...During that run, the FSL Mid-Season All-Star batted .406 (13-32) with 5 runs scored and 5 runs batted in.

IT'S STU SEASON: OF **Stuart Fairchild** has found his stroke at the plate since coming back from a slight hamstring injury on May 4...In 32 games since missing a week of action, the 23-year-old has compiled a .322 average (39-121) with 19 runs scored, 12 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 27 runs batted in, 2 stolen bases, 13 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches...During the run, Fairchild has slashed .322/.399/.562 with a .961 OPS...Over his last 33 games - going back to April 27 vs. Bradenton - the Dominican native has reached base in 30-of-33 contests and picked up a base-hit in 25 of those affairs...In his first 14 games, Fairchild was slashing .113/.175/.151 with a 6-for-53 ledger at the dish...In 33 affairs since, he is slashing .328/.407/.566 with 18 extra-base hits and raised his batting average 150 points from .113 to .263.

LIVIN' LA VIDA LÓPEZ: 2B **Alejo López** has been a key part of Daytona's offense all season long...On Monday night, the 23-year-old had his Florida State League season-high 22-game on-base streak snapped...During the stretch from May 17-June 12, López accumulated a .305 average (25-82) with 12 runs scored, 5 doubles, 8 runs batted in, 7 walks, and a .376 OBP...The switch-hitter had an on-base streak of 14 games earlier in the campaign from April 9-24...During that run, López registered an impressive .357 average (20-56) with 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, 10 RBI, 2 walks, and 2 hit-by-pitches...The Phoenix, Ariz. resident slashed .357/.400/.518 with a .918 OPS in that span...López surpassed teammate SS **José García** (20), as well as Tampa's **Diego Castillo** and Dunedin's **Cullen Large** for the longest on-base streak in the FSL this year.

THE STARTING LINE: After a rough start to May, Daytona's rotation turned a corner in the final week-plus of the month and carried it into June...Over the last 28 games, the Tortugas' starting pitchers have accumulated just a 5-9 record, but maintain a sparkling 2.51 ERA (41 ER in 147.0 IP)...During that span, Daytona's starters have accrued 130 hits allowed, 127 strikeouts and just 30 walks...The Tortugas hold a 16-12 clip during those 28 games...The run has also featured a four-game stretch (May 22-25) where Daytona starters did not issue an earned run...The Tortugas went just 2-2 in those games, but tallied 23 straight games without yielding an ERA-increasing tally...Daytona has also posted 10 quality starts during the stretch...Prior to this recent collection of starts, the 'Tugas starting staff had gone 4-5 with a 5.58 ERA (37 ER in 59.2 IP), 78 hits allowed, 13 walks, and 53 strikeouts in 13 games.

FLYING HIGH: During Tuesday evening's 9-4 victory over Lakeland, Daytona's offense collected several high-water marks for the 2019 season...The Tortugas set a season-best for runs and hits in a single game, scoring 7 times on 7 hits during the 2nd inning...Daytona's previous season-best came when they scored 6 runs in a single-frame on two occasions...The 'Tugas scratched across 6 tallies in the 4th inning vs. Lakeland on May 11 and in the 5th vs. Palm Beach on May 6...The 7 knocks in an inning overtook their previous high of 6, which was done two times...Daytona had 6 hits in the 5th on May 6 vs. Palm Beach and in the 2nd on May 3 at Clearwater...The 7 hits in a single inning is the most by Daytona since they had 7 hits in the 6th inning in a 12-8 win vs. Palm Beach on August 11, 2017...The 7 runs in a half-inning were the most by the 'Tugas in a single frame since they scored 8 runs in the 5th inning during a 14-3 win at Jupiter on April 27, 2017...Additionally, Daytona added 5 doubles, matching a previous season-high from June 1 at Jupiter and game two of a doubleheader on May 20 vs. Clearwater...The 16 team hits matched most in a single-game in 2019...The Tortugas also racked up 16 knocks on May 6 vs. Palm Beach.

NOT SO FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Tortugas have put up better results in visiting ballparks than in their own in 2019...Entering Tuesday, Daytona holds a 19-11 mark in games played in opposing stadiums...In affairs held at Jackie Robinson Ballpark, the Tortugas record drops to 177-19...In contests played as the road team, Daytona has a .258 team batting average (299-1158) with 143 runs scored (4.3/g), 75 extra-base hits (2.3/g), 13 home runs (0.4/g), as well as 95 walks (2.9/g)...At home, the Tortugas average dips by 24 points down to .234 (250-1067)...Additionally, the team has scored 129 runs (3.91/g), 82 extra-base hits (2.5/g), 20 home runs (0.6/g), and 93 walks (2.8/g)...On the mound, Daytona's team ERA is slightly better in their own ballpark (3.39), as opposed to visiting parks (3.57)...3B **Jonathan India** has been better on the road this season, too...The 22-year-old holds a .288 clip (34-118) with 18 runs scored, 10 extra-base knocks, 3 homers, and 9 RBI in 29 road games...At home, India is batting .223 (25-112) with 19 runs scored, 9 extra-base hits, 5 home runs, and 15 RBI in 32 games...C **Hendrik Clementina** has also thrived away from Daytona Beach...Entering Tuesday, he holds a .256 mark (22-86) with 3 homers and 12 RBI in 21 games on the road...At home, he is batting just .196 (18-92) with 2 long balls and 8 RBI in 26 affairs...OF **Andy Sugilio**'s batting average splits are also quite different...The 22-year-old is hitting .333 (38-114) away from The Jack and .268 (26-97) within its confines.

BOYS GO TO JUPITER: The Tortugas had five players selected to the Florida State League All-Star Game, which was held this past Saturday at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium in Jupiter...C **Hendrik Clementina** (0-1), 3B **Jonathan India** (0-2; 2nd), 2B **Alejo Lopez** (0-2, SO; 7th), LHP **Packy Naughton** (DNP), and RHP **Ryan Nufot** (DNP) were the honorees...A sixth was added after the initial release, as OF **Andy Sugilio** (0-2, SO) will replace Lakeland's **Luke Burch**...RHP **Julo Pinto** (1-0 IP) was added as a seventh player, replacing Nufot who was promoted to Double-A...Daytona was tied with the Clearwater Threshers for the most players represented on the North Division squad (7)...The Fort Myers Miracle had the most players chosen to the contest with 8...India, Lopez, Nufot, Pinto, and Sugilio were selected as Mid-Season All-Stars for the first time in their careers...India is in his 2nd pro season, Lopez is in his 5th, Nufot his 3rd, Sugilio his 6th, and Pinto his 7th...Naughton had previously been chosen as a Mid-Season All-Star with Rookie Billings in the Pioneer League in 2017...Clementina made the Pioneer League Mid-Season All-Star squad in 2017 with Rookie Ogden and then again in the Midwest League with Low-A Dayton in 2018...Last season, the Tortugas had 8 players chosen to the contest: RHPs **Ryan Hendrix**, **Joel Kuhnel**, and **Tony Santillan**, as well as C **Tyler Stephenson**, 2B **Brantley Bell**, 3B **Mitch Nay**, and OFs **T.J. Friedl** and **Taylor Trammell**.
