## SYRACUSE METS NEWS AND NOTES.

Ruben's Rocketing the Ball: Ruben Tejada tallied another hit Saturday night. Tejada has 15 hits over the last nine games ( $15 \times 34, .441$ ) with three doubles, a home run, five RBI, five walks and a .513 OBP. Since joining Syracuse on May 23rd, Tejada ranks among the league leaders in that time in average (4th, .344), OBP (3rd, .429), hits (T3rd, 52), OPS (11th, .952), and runs (T1st, 34).

Maester Rajai: Rajai Davis had three hits Saturday, his fourth multi-hit game in his last five. Davis has at least one hit in five of his last six games, going $12 \times 25$ (.480).

Say Hey Rene: Despite not tallying a hit Friday, Rene Rivera has been an offensive force for the Mets this year. Just in the last few days, Rivera had two hits, a home run and two RBI last Saturday, his first career three home run game on Sunday, and a stretch of four straight games with an RBI from Saturday-Tuesday. Rivera has accomplished a number of offensive feats this season, all since May 1st. Rivera has posted two four-hit games in 2019 (most recently June 11th), something he had not done previously since June 20, 2013 (Tucson vs. Colorado Springs). Sunday marked Rivera's second multi-home run game of the season and sixth of his career (had not achieved it since 2017). His four RBI Sunday also tied a career high, the second time he's accomplished that this year (also did it as a member of the Red Wings on 7/30/12 at Columbus). Since May 1st, Rivera is hitting .291 in 49 games with 28 runs, five doubles, 12 home runs, 43 RBI, and 13 walks. Over that period, Rivera is tied for fourth in the league in RBI. Rivera has driven in at least two runs 14 times this year, and has multiple hits in 15 games, with all coming since May 1st.
Inside the Roster: The Syracuse Mets roster (not including rehabbers) in 2019 has featured players with 11,322 games of MLB experience ( 9,472 position players, 1,850 pitchers). That includes more than 6,000 in the outfield alone (Altherr, Blanco, Davis, Gomez, Kemp, Lee, Liriano). The roster has produced 9,565 MLB hits, 1,891 doubles, 1,079 home runs and 4,452 RBI. The pitchers have combined to strike out 3,979 batters. Add in the seven rehabbers that have suited up for Syracuse this year (Frazier, Lowrie, Cano, Nimmo, Wilson, Avilan, Familia) and they bring 5,817 games of experience to the table. Thus having allowed Syracuse fans to see a team with 17,139 games of MLB experience this year.

SYR in the IL: Among qualifiers: Dilson Herrera is tied for tenth in home runs (17), 12th in SLG (.546), and 12th in XBH (34)...Travis Taijeron is tied tenth in walks (41)...Danny Espinosa is tied for 13th in RBI (49)...Rajai Davis is tied for first in stolen bases (17)...As a pitching staff, the Mets have induced the most double plays (81**, eight more than Gwinnett)...Offensively, the Mets are tied for third in stolen bases ( 74 , though they have only stolen three bases over the last 11 games).
**Syracuse's 81 double plays are the most turned in all of Minor League Baseball
Cuse Bites: Chris Mazza was named an International League All-Star Saturday, joining Dilson Herrera. Mazza was named International League Pitcher of the Week for the weeks of June 10-16 and May 20-26 this year...Ruben Tejada's cycle on June 19th at Charlotte came just 19 days after Travis Taijeron hit for a cycle on May 31st at Pawtucket. Those are the first two cycles achieved by a Syracuse player since August 25, 1987 by Sil Campusano against Richmond...Dilson Herrera's home run June 19th gave him home runs in four consecutive games, a Mets season high...The Mets’ Triple Play on June 7th was the first turned by Syracuse since July 22, 2012 vs. Norfolk.. Syracuse's 18 runs on April 30th were its most score in a game since also scoring 18 on May 14, 2006 at Charlotte ( $18-6$ win)...The Mets have come from behind to at least tie the game 25 times this year. They have totaled 16 comeback wins...The Mets have posted three four-game winning streaks this season.

Syracuse to New York Pipeline: Chris Mazza had his contract selected by New York last Wednesday and made his Major League debut Friday night. All together, 20 players have been recalled or selected from Syracuse to New York this year. In total, 27 different players have already appeared on both Syracuse and New York's roster this season.
