- **TODAY'S GAME:** The M-Braves and Montgomery Biscuits begin a five-game series on Saturday night at Riverwalk Stadium. The Biscuits took 3 of 5 from the M-Braves over a series at Trustmark Park, April 20-24. This is the sixth of 10 total meetings (2-3) between the clubs in 2019.
- This series is the first leg of a 10-game road trip in the state of Alabama. The M-Braves will take on the Birmingham Barons, May 16-20, at Regions Field
- M-BRAVES FINISH 10-GAME HOMESTAND, 7-3: The M-Braves began the homestand by sweeping a five-game series from Jacksonville, May 1-5, just the fourth, five-game sweep in club history. The Braves went 2-3 against Pensacola.
- M Over the 10 games, Mississippi posted a 1.48 ERA, holding the opposition to just 15 ER in 91 innings with 31 walks and 86 strikeouts. At the plate, the M-Braves batted .216 with seven doubles, two triples, five home runs and seven total bases. Drew Waters led the offense, batting .400 (16x40) with two doubles, a home run, three RBI and five runs scored.
- MAY ON THE MOUND: The M-Braves are 7-3 to begin the month of May, posting a 1.48 ERA (15 ER/91.0 IP) with 86 strikeouts, 31 walks and a .198 opponents batting average.
- LAST TIME OUT: 1B Andy Wilkins hit a two-run homer in the first inning and a solo shot in the sixth, while LF **Connor Lien** added another as Mississippi finished up the homestand with a 4-1 victory over Pensacola on Friday night. LHP **Kyle Muller** worked 7.0 innings for a second-straight start, yielding just one run on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts. RHP **Jason Hursh** pitched a scoreless eighth and RHP Josh Graham added a scoreless ninth for his fourth save
- WATERS SETTING THE TABLE: OF Drew Waters is batting .432 (19-for-44) over his last 11 games since April 29, with a home run, five doubles, three RBI and seven runs scored. Waters has recorded seven three-hit games this season and logged his 14th multi-hit game on Friday night.
- $m{M}$ Waters leads the Southern League in batting (.343), XBH (18), doubles (14) and total bases (71), is T-1st in hits (46), 2nd in slugging (.530), OPS (.906) and at-bats (134) and T-2nd in runs (21).
- PACHE BY THE NUMBERS: OF Cristian Pache leads the Southern League in triples (4), T-2nd in XBH (15) and total bases (61), 4th in slugging (.521), OPS (.876) and doubles (8), T-4th in hits (36), 6th in batting (.308) and T-6th in RBI (19).
- PITCHING, PITCHING AND MORE PITCHING: The M-Braves pitching staff ranks 2nd in the Southern League with a 2.93 ERA. The starting rotation carries a 2.81 ERA and the bullpen has a 3.14 ERA.
- DON'T LET THE NAME FOOL YA: RHP Jeremy Walker has gone 4+ innings in all six of his relief appearances behind Patrick Weigel and has allowed just nine earned runs in 31.0 IP with just two walks and 26 strikeouts. He ranks 9th in the league in ERA (2.63).
- NEVER TOO OLD TO ROCK 'N' ROLL, JUST 21 YEARS OLD: RHP Ian Anderson is T-2nd in the Southern League in strikeouts with 42 strikeouts over seven starts and ranks 10th in opponents batting AVG, .193.
- FIVE-GAME SERIES SWEEP: The M-Braves swept a five-game series from Jacksonville, May 1-5, just the fourth, five-game sweep in club history. The Southern League went to the five-game series format in 2008, the last came Aug. 22-26, 2014 vs. Birmingham. M-Braves' pitchers held the Shrimp to just three runs over 46 innings, with 49 strikeouts, holding them to a .173 batting average.
- THIRD-MOST TALENTED TEAM IN MILB: MLB Pipeline ranked all 120-full season Minor League teams to open the season and the M-Braves roster ranked as the No. 3 most talented team in MiLB. Triple-A Gwinnett was ranked fifth
- TEN TOP 30 PROSPECTS ON ROSTER: They include RHP Ian Anderson (2), OF Cristian Pache (3), OF Drew Waters (7), LHP Joey Wentz (11), LHP Kyle Muller (12), RHP Huascar Ynoa (13), RHP Patrick Weigel (18), LHP Tucker Davidson (21), INF C.J Alexander (IL 22) and INF Ray-Patrick Didder (29)... three top 100 prospects in baseball according to MLB.com (Anderson (28), Pache (31) and Waters
- YOUNG GUNS: The roster contains six players that are 21-years-old, or younger. OF Drew Waters is the youngest (20, 12/30/98), followed by OF Cristian Pache (20, 11/19/98), RHP Huascar Ynoa (20, 5/28/98), RHP lan Anderson (21, 5/2/98), LHP Joey Wentz (21, 10/6/97) and LHP Kyle Muller (21,

TODAY'S GAME

 Atlanta's No. 18 prospect according to MLB.com, Patrick Weigel makes his seventh start of 2019 as he continues to work his way back from Tommy John Surgery. RHP Jeremy Walker has pitched behind Weigel in each of his first six starts of 2019, going 1-3 with a 2.61 ERA (9 ER/31.0 IP), two walks, 26 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT

 Weigel tossed worked 3.0 innings for the second-straight start, coming away with a no-decision in the 6-3 loss to Pensacola last Monday at Trustmark Park. Weigel struck out two and walked none, needing just 29 pitches to get through 3.0 innings.

- Enters the 2019 season as the No. 19 prospect in the organization according to MLB. com and No. 12 prospect according to Baseball America.
- His start on 4/7 was his first (non GCL) start in 658 days, 6/8/17 w/Gwinnett.

2018 SEASON

- Placed on Gwinnett's disabled list on 4/6 and missed the majority of the season while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery, performed on 6/27/17.
- Made just four rehabilitation appearances (three starts) with the GCL Braves, and tossed 4.0 scoreless innings with two hits and six strikeouts.
- Atlanta selected his contract on 11/20 (added to 40-man roster).
- Entered the season tabbed by Baseball America as Atlanta's No. 16 prospect and by MLB.com as No. 17.
