Wes Benjamin recorded eight of the 15 strikeouts across four innings in his Double-A debut. However, his counterpart, Justin De Fratus, allowed just three hits across six shutout innings to help the Drillers to a series win.

PUNCHOUT PARTY: Riders pitchers recorded 38 strikeouts in the three-game series against Tulsa, notching at least 10 in each game.

- Entering play today, the staff has the third-most strikeouts in Minor League Baseball, trailing only Advanced-A Potomac (44) and Advanced-A Inland Empire (39).
Notable strikeout performers from the Tulsa series include Wes Benjamin (8 Ks in 4 innings Saturday) and Jeffrey Springs ( 5 Ks in 2 innings of relief Friday).

READY IN RELIEF: The Riders bullpen has been fantastic through the season's first three games, notching a Texas Leaguebest 1.35 ERA in three games ( 2 ER in $131 / 3$ IP).

- Relievers have amassed 21 of their 40 outs via strikeouts this season.
- The Opening Day roster features a deep bullpen, with eight active players plus Major League rehabber Tony Barnette, who has thrown a scoreless inning in each of the first two contests.

COOL DEWDS: Three of the four pitching newcomers from Advanced-A Down East made their Double-A debuts in the Tulsa series, with each dazzling in their first game with the Riders.

- Alvarez played in 54 games with Springfield last season, hitting 247 with four homers and 26 RBIs. He was limited by a left ankle sprain, which sidelined him for more than two months.
- He was traded to the Phillies organization in early September before the Rangers acquired him in a trade on March 21.

- By comparison, only eight returners were part of last year's Opening Day roster.
- Additionally, manager Joe Mikulik, hitting coach Jason Hart, athletic trainer Jacob Newburn and strength \& conditioning coach Wade Lamont are back from last year's staff.

SCORING POSITION STRUGGLES: The Riders have already had a wealth of chances with runners in scoring position but are only 6-29 (.207) in those spots.

- Eliezer Alvarez has paced the club in the clutch department early, going 2-3 with RISP. The rest of the club is 4-26.
- Last year, RISP hitting plagued the club, with the Riders hitting just . 228 when runners were at second and/or third base.
