CLOCKING EXTRA TIME IN THE OPENER: The Riders and Tulsa played into extra innings to begin the season's opening road trip Thursday night, with the Riders falling 4-3 in 11 innings. D.J. Peters finished off the marathon with a walk-off walk. The Riders had leads of 1-0 and 3-2 but were unable to hold on. Scott Heineman paved the way yet again for the Riders, going 3-4 with a run and a walk.

ALL ABOARD THE EXPRESS: Earlier today, Scott Heineman and Tommy Joseph were promoted to Triple-A Round Rock. Heineman is in Triple-A for the first time while Joseph is back at the level for the first time since 2016, when he played with the Phillies-affiliated Lehigh Valley IronPigs.

LITTERING THE LEADERBOARD: Texas League pitchers can let out a sigh of relief now that Scott Heineman is out of the league and in Triple-A. Heineman was off to a roaring start in the season's first week for the Riders.

- Entering play Friday, Heineman led the league in average (.522) and OBP (.613), while ranking near the top in hits (T2nd, 12), RBIs (T2nd, 10), slugging percentage (3rd, .739) and walks (T3rd, 7).
- Heineman leaves Frisco on a six-game hitting streak, in which he hit . 632 (12-19).
- He reached safely in eight consecutive plate appearances on two different occasions to begin the season (4/7-4/9 and 4/10-4/12).
- In just seven games, he logged two three-hit games and two three-RBI games. He amassed just 11 games with three-or-more hits last year and three games with three RBls (out of 117 total games).

LEAPING TO THE BIG LEAGUES: Former Riders 1B Ronald Guzman was recalled by the Rangers earlier today and is in tonight's lineup at Houston, seeking his Major League debut.

- Guzman played for the Riders in 2016, hitting 288 with 15 home runs and 56 RBIs in 102 games.
- The Dominican lefty was named the Rangers Minor League Player of the Year last season with Triple-A Round Rock (. 298,12 HR, 62 RBI in 125 games).
- Once he debuts tonight, he'll become the 142 nd former Riders player to make the big leagues and the second this week, joining Isiah Kiner-Falefa, who debuted with the Rangers Tuesday.

UNTOUCHABLE OUT OF THE PEN: The Riders bullpen has been one of the club's strong suits in the early going.

- Relievers have compiled a Texas League-best 1.84 ERA (6 ER in 29 1/3 IP) through the season's first seven games, with three of the six earned runs coming Tuesday vs. Springfield.
- Five of the eight relievers have still not yielded an earned run this year: Adam Choplick, Clayton Cook, Tyler Davis, Brady Feigl and Cody Palmquist.
- 36 of the bullpen's 88 outs have come via strikeouts.

PRIME TIME: Infielder Correlle Prime joined the Riders earlier today after signing with the Rangers as a Minor League free agent.

- Prime comes to the Rangers organization after six years with the Rockies system. He made it as high as Double-A Hartford before getting released at the end of this year's Spring Training.
- The 24-year-old was the Rockies Minor League Player of the Year after hitting . 291 with 21 home runs and 102 RBIs for Class-A Asheville.
He was originally a 12th-round pick of the Rockies in 2012 out of Manatee High School (Bradenton, FL).
