**BIG FLIES SINK RIDERS IN FINALE:** Three late solo home runs proved to be the difference Saturday in Tulsa, as the Riders dropped the series finale to the Drillers by a count of 5-4. After **Preston Beck** put the Riders ahead with a two-run shot in the top of the sixth, the Drillers tied the game on a solo homer from **Michael Ahmed** in the bottom of the frame before hitting back-to-back homers in the seventh (**Will Smith** and **Connor Joe**) to take the lead for good and complete the sweep of the Riders.

**RESURGENT SERIES FOR BECK:** Outfielder **Preston Beck** started to turn things around in Tulsa after a slow start at the plate this season.

- Beck went 4-for-14 with a double, a home run and four RBIs in Tulsa after going 1-for-18 on the opening homestand.
- The lefty slugger turned in consecutive two-hit games to finish the series against the Drillers.
- A Dallas native, Beck is starting his third season with the Riders (also 2015 and 2016).

**ROLLING RIGHT ALONG:** Outfielder **Hunter Cole** is off to a tremendous start in 2018, including a 2-for-3, three-run showing last night in Tulsa.

- He enters play today ranking third in the league with a .429 average.
- Cole has two hits in five of his first eight games with the Riders this season, including each of the last two nights.
- The righty swinger is in his first year with the Rangers organization after playing the first four years of his pro career in the Giants system. He was traded to the Rangers in November as the player-to-be-named-later in a deal for **Sam Dyson**.

**REVVING UP THE BAT:** Catcher **Jose Trevino** is finding his rhythm after a slow start to the season.

- Trevino is batting .348 (8-for-23) since starting the season in an 0-10 slump.
- The second-year Riders backstop enters play today on a six-game hitting streak, tied for the longest streak on the team in the young season (also **Scott Heineman**).

**RACKING UP THE PUNCHOUTS:** Riders pitchers amassed 12 strikeouts last night against Tulsa.

- Frisco pitchers have racked up 91 strikeouts through the season's first nine games, trailing only San Antonio (103) on the Texas League leaderboard.
- Riders pitchers have notched at least 10 strikeouts in seven of the first nine games, including in all six battles against Tulsa.

**RE-EMERGING HOME RUN ISSUES:** Riders pitchers have surrendered 10 homers in nine games to begin the year, accounting for 15 of the 43 runs the club has allowed.

- Six of the 10 homers came in the three-game series at Tulsa, including three last night.
- Last year's staff set a new franchise record for most homers allowed in a season (146).

**RELIABLE STARTERS:** Riders starters did their part to keep the club in the ballgame during the three-game set at Tulsa. The trio of **Collin Wiles**, **Wes Benjamin** and **Pedro Payano** combined for a 2.93 ERA in the three games and worked out of numerous jams, stranding 18 runners in their 15 1/3 innings of work.

**RIDING THE E-TRAIN TO TRIPLE-A:** Friday, **Scott Heineman** and **Tommy Joseph** were promoted to Triple-A Round Rock. Heineman is in Triple-A for the first time while Joseph is back at the level for the first time since 2016, when he played with the Phillies-affiliated Lehigh Valley IronPigs.

- Heineman led the league in average (.522) and OBP (.613), while ranking near the top in hits (T2nd, 12), RBIs (T2nd, 10), slugging percentage (3rd, .739) and walks (T3rd, 7). He was also on a six-game hitting streak, batting .632 (12-19) when he got the promotion to Round Rock.
- Joseph had hits in six of his seven games with the Riders. He homered in his Round Rock debut last night.

**ROUNDING THE BASES FOR THE FIRST TIME:** Former Riders **Isiah Kiner-Falefa** (2016-2017) and **Ronald Guzman** (2016) each hit their first-career homers yesterday for the Rangers in Houston. The two collected their first big league hits in their first Major League starts Friday against the Astros.

### NOTES

#### 2018 SEASON

- Last start (Monday vs. Springfield): Made his Double-A debut and took a tough loss against the Cardinals. Two of four runs scored on sac flies.

#### 2017 SEASON

- Enters 2018 as the Rangers 15th-best prospect in the eyes of MLB Pipeline and is ranked 18th by *Baseball America*.
- Pitched all year with Advanced-A Down East, helping the Wood Ducks to a Carolina League co-championship.
- Struck out a career-high 10 batters May 6 vs. Wilmington.
- Placed on the DL following that start with a right abdominal strain and was out nearly two months.
- Turned in a season-best seven innings and allowed two runs on three hits with eight strikeouts August 26 vs. Lynchburg.
- Struck out seven batters or more in five of his 16 starts.
- Walked at least one batter in each of his 16 starts with three-or-more free passes in six (season/career-high five walks August 19 vs. Buies Creek).
- Made 10 of his 16 starts at home and had a noticeably lower ERA at Grainger Stadium (3.76) than on the road (6.25).

#### CAREER NOTES

- Is one of seven Rangers farmhands to win a championship ring each of the last three seasons (2015 - Class-A Hickory, 2016 - Advanced-A High Desert, 2017 - Advanced-A Buies Creek).
- Has been on the DL for significant stints each of the last three years, totaling 129 days on the shelf.
  - > 2015: left knee strain (8/1-8/8) and right hip strain (8/29-9/14)
  - > 2016: left elbow strain (6/6-8/8)
  - > 2017: right abdominal strain (5/12-6/28)
- Turned in the best start of his career in game two of the 2016 California League Championship Series vs. Visalia, dealing seven no-hit innings while recording 15 strikeouts.
- Named a 2015 South Atlantic League Midseason All-Star with Class-A Hickory.
- Grew up near Knoxville, TN and is a huge Tennessee Volunteers fan. Originally attended UT before transferring to Walters State Community College (in his hometown of Morristown) before spring of his FR year.
- While at Walters St., played w/ current Rays farmhand Brent Honeywell.
