WALK-OFF WEDNESDAY AT THE WOLFF: The Missions came from behind to walk-off the Riders 8-7 Wednesday night at Wolff Stadium. Austin Allen hit the game-winning homer in the ninth, helping San Antonio complete a comeback from a 7-4 deficit. The Riders did all their scoring in two innings, tallying four runs in the third and three more in the fifth. Correlle Prime and Chuck Moorman each went deep in the defeat.

ADIOS TO LOW RUN TOTALS: The Riders and Missions have historically played low-scoring games at Wolff Stadium but that changed in last night's 8-7 battle.

- The Riders only scored more than six runs once in 16 games at The Wolff last year and all nine runs came in one inning August 22.
- San Antonio, meanwhile, hadn't scored more than eight runs at home against the Riders since plating 11 runs June 8, 2016 (27 games with seven runs or fewer in between).

LIFT OFF: With two home runs last night, the Riders went deep multiple times in a game for the frist time this season. The Riders enter play today tied with Northwest Arkansas for the fewest team homers in the Texas League (8).

KEEPING THE BALL IN THE YARD PROVES TRICKY: Conversely, Riders opponents have had no issues putting the ball over the fence in the season's first few weeks.

- Riders arms have surrendered 29 home runs in the first 19 games, tied with Midland for most in the Texas League.
- Opponents have gone deep twice in four consecutive games.
- Overall, the Riders have allowed at least one homer in 15 of 19 games this year.
- Frisco arms gave up three sets of back-to-back homers on the last road trip and have allowed four clusters of back-toback jacks already this year.
- Last year's staff set a new franchise record for most homers allowed in a season (146). This year's group is on a pace to surrender 214 roundtrippers. The Texas League single-season record is 178 (Arkansas, 2006).

O'NEILL OFF TO GREAT START: Outfielder Michael O'Neill is off to a great start with the Riders since joining the club in the second week of the season.

- The second-year Riders outfielder has reached safely in all 12 games he's played, notching hits in 10 (two five-game histting streaks).
- O'Neill was on the Riders preliminary roster but promoted to Triple-A Round Rock right before the season. He played in six games with the Express, hitting .182 with an RBI before trading places with the hot-hitting Scott Heineman on April 13.

FLASHING THE LEATHER: The Riders defense had quite the produtive last seven games, turning 16 double plays, accumulating four outfield assists, catching four runners stealing and picking off two. After the double play flurry, the Riders have taken over the top spot in the league in that category (23).

FIVE RUNS FEEL GOOD: All four Riders wins this year have come when the team scores at least five runs. By contrast, the Riders are 0-12 when amassing four runs or fewer.
