GETTING OUT OF INNINGS TROUBLES RIDERS IN 5-3 LOSS: The Riders allowed four two-out runs Thursday in the opener against Corpus Christi, falling 5-3 to the Hooks. Frisco overcame deficits of 2-0 and 3-2 to tie the game but the Hooks plated the decisive runs in the top of the eighth. The Riders rallied to the end, loading the bases with two outs in the ninth before Hooks reliever Riley Ferrell shut the door for good.

O'NEILL OFF TO STRONG START: Outfielder Michael O'Neill went deep last night, continuing his hot start to his second season in Frisco.

- O'Neill comes into play tonight riding a five-game hitting streak, in which he is hitting .333.
- He has reached safely in all six games he's played with the Riders.
- The former Michigan Wolverine started 2018 at Triple-A Round Rock and hit . 182 with an RBI in six games. He was transferred to Frisco as the corresponding move to Scott Heineman's promotion to Round Rock after his sizzling start to the year with the Riders (. 522 avg, $1 \mathrm{HR}, 10 \mathrm{RBI}$ in seven games).
- Originally in the Yankees organization, O'Neill played his first season with the Rangers last year, finishing the campaign with the Riders after spending the season's first two months at Advanced-A Down East.

LET TREVINO SHINE: Riders catcher Jose Trevino will be presented with his 2017 Rawlings Minor League Gold Glove Award prior to tonight's game.

Last year with the Riders, Trevino made just three errors in 99 games, threw out $41 \%$ of attempted base stealers, picked off four runners and only allowed three passed balls.

- This is his second consecutive Gold Glove after winning the honor in 2016 with Advanced-A High Desert.
- Trevino is the 19th player in Minor League Baseball history to win the award twice. Only four players have done it three times (the award has been in existence from 1957-1984 and 2011-present).

DING(ER) DING(ER): Riders pitching has had its troubles keeping the ball in the yard through the season's first two weeks.

- Riders arms have surrendered 20 home runs in the first 13 games, second-most in the Texas League (Midland, 21).
- Opponents have gone deep at least once in eight consecutive games and 10 of 13 this year.
- Frisco arms gave up three sets of back-to-back homers on the recent road trip and have allowed four clusters of back-to-back jacks already this year.
- Last year's staff set a new franchise record for most homers allowed in a season (146). This year's group is on a pace to surrender 215 roundtrippers. The Texas League single-season record is 178 (Arkansas, 2006).

END THE STREAK: The Riders enter play tonight on a seven-game losing streak. It's their longest since an an eight-game skid August 23-31, 2016. The franchise record is 13 games (July 3-16, 2005).

NEARING A RETURN TO FULL HEALTH: Rangers outfielder Delino Deshields is scheduled to continue a rehab assignment with the Riders tonight after going 1 -for- 3 with a bunt single yesterday.

- Deshields went on the DL March 31 with a fractured hamate bone in his left hand.
- This is his first time suiting up for the Riders. However, he has previous Texas League experience, having played for the Hooks in 2014. He was a Midseason All-Star that season for Corpus Christi, batting . 236 with 11 home runs and 57 RBIs.
