LAST TIME OUT: The Fire Frogs snapped Daytona's 4-game winning streak on Tuesday, as Florida defeated the Tortugas, 4-0, in front of 1,884 fans at Jackie Robinson Ballpark...Florida did their damage early, scoring 3 runs in the top of the first on a 2-run shot by DH **Trey Harris** (2-5, R, HR, 2 RBI, SO) and a solo blast from 1B **Drew Luga** (2-4, R, 2B, HR, RBI, BB, SO)...SS **Riley Delgado** (4-4, R) was the catalyst for the Frogs, reaching base 5 times...3B **Kevin Josephina** (2-4, R, 2B, SO) and 2B **Jordan Rodgers** (2-4, RBI, SO) each added multi-hit games for Florida...3B **Jonathan India** (2-4, 2B) led Daytona's offense, picking 2 of the team's 3 hits...RHP **Nolan Kingham** (9.0 IP, 3 H, BB, 7 SO) was superb for the Fire Frogs, throwing just 91 pitches to hurl a complete game shutout...The blanking was Kingham's 3rd of the year and helped him garner his 4th win...LHP **Wennington Romero** (5.0 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 7 SO) struck out a season-best 7, but suffered his 1st defeat.

TODAY'S FIRE FROGS STARTER: In the series finale, Florida is expected to hand the ball to LHP **Philip Pfeifer**...Struck out a season-high 9, but suffered the defeat in his last start on Wednesday night vs. Dunedin (5.1 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 9 SO)...In 7 starts for Florida, holds an 0-3 mark with a 4.00 ERA (16 ER in 36.0 IP) and 44 strikeouts...Transferred to Florida from Double-A Mississippi on April 29...Collected a 1-1 record with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP) in 7 relief appearances for the M-Braves...Began the 2018 with Triple-A Gwinnett and was transferred to Mississippi on June 9, going 0-0 with a 2.51 ERA (4 ER in 14.1 IP) in 10 appearances...Transferred back to Triple-A Gwinnett on August 1...Hauled in a 2-3 mark with a 6.86 ERA (31 ER in 40.2 IP) in 29 outings (1 start) for the Strippers...Non-roster invitee to Atlanta Braves' Spring Training in 2018...Ranked as Atlanta's No. 29 prospect by *Baseball America* entering the 2018 campaign...Acquired by the Braves with RHP **Caleb Dirks** from the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for RHP **Bud Norris**, OF **Dian Toscano**, and a player to be named later (RHP **Alec Grosser**) on July 8, 2016...Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 3rd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of Vanderbilt University...Signed for \$222,500...Selected by the Texas Rangers in the 44th round of the 2011 MLB Draft out of Farragut High School (Knoxville, Tenn.), but did not sign...Won 4 state titles and set the Tennessee state record for wins (46) in high school...Attended high school with former Tortuga and current Reds OF **Nick Senzel**.

FAULTY RUBBER: The Tortugas have gotten off to a rough start in series-deciding matches in 2019, losing each of their first 5 opportunities...On June 2, Daytona fell to the Jupiter Hammerheads, 4-3, at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium...At The Jack on May 8, the 'Tugas fell to the Palm Beach Cardinals, 2-1...On May 2, Daytona lost, 6-2, to the Dunedin Blue Jays, a game that saw 55 minutes worth of rain delays...Daytona fell to the Tampa Tarpons, 4-3, at home on April 14 in a game that featured a pair of 40-plus minute rain delays...The Tortugas followed that with a loss against the Jupiter Hammerheads, 1-0, at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium on April 17...In 5 series-deciding games, Daytona has only been outscored by a total of 17-9 with 4 one-run defeats...Despite a stellar overall season in 2018, Daytona struggled mightily in rubber matches, accruing a 3-12 record in those affairs...Dat- ing back to a May 3 loss at Jupiter last season, the Tortugas have lost 16-of-their-last-17 rubber matches...They have not won a series-deciding game in the regular season since a 5-1 win at Dunedin on April 22, 2018.

FRESH START: After missing out on clinching a playoff berth in the first half, the Tortugas will begin a new push to the postseason, as the second half got underway on Monday evening...With the All-Star Game serving as the halfway point for the Florida State League in 2019, Daytona will play 73 games in the season's second leg...38 of those contests will be at Jackie Robinson Ballpark and 35 will be in visiting ballparks...In 5 years since the rebrand, the Tortugas have mustered a winning record in the first half in each season (178-157)...The organization has not had a losing first half since the Daytona Cubs went 26-42 in the first half of 2014...Comparatively, the 'Tugas have not had a winning second half since they accumulated a 40-28 record, while finishing in 3rd place in the North in 2016...In the last 2 years, Daytona has gone 52-85 in the second half (.380)...Since becoming the Tortugas in 2015, Daytona has not won an outright second half title...In 2015, the team clinched a wild card berth in the second half as a result of holding the second-best overall record in the North Division after Clearwater won both halves...Daytona has not won a second-half crown outright since the 2014 Daytona Cubs did it with a 41-27 record.

ANDY'S ALWAYS ON: OF **Andy Sugilio** has been red hot for Daytona lately...The 22-year-old had a season-high 9-game hitting streak snapped on Tuesday...Starting on June 4, Sugilio collected a .432 average (16-37) with 7 runs scored, a double, a triple, 3 runs batted in, and 4 stolen bases...The switch-hitter slashed a .432/.462/.514 line with a .975 OPS and .552 BABIP...Prior to Tuesday, the switch-hitter had accumulated 6 consecutive multi-hit games...In those affairs, the Dominican native was 13-for-27 at the plate (.481 AVG) with a double and 2 RBI...As Daytona's leadoff hitter, Sugilio has posted a .333 average (11-33) in 7 games...Sugilio's previous season-high was an 8-game hitting streak from April 26-May 7...During that run, the FSL Mid-Season All-Star batted .406 (13-32) with 5 runs scored and 5 runs batted in.

IT'S STU SEASON: OF **Stuart Fairchild** has found his stroke at the plate since coming back from a slight hamstring injury on May 4...In 33 games since missing a week of action, the 23-year-old has compiled a .315 average (39-124) with 19 runs scored, 12 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 27 runs batted in, 2 stolen bases, 13 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches...During the run, Fairchild has slashed .315/.390/.548 with a .938 OPS...Over his last 34 games - going back to April 27 vs. Bradenton - the Seattle, Wash. native has reached base in 30-of-34 contests and picked up a base-hit in 25 of those affairs...In his first 14 games, Fairchild was slashing .143/.175/.151 with a 6-for-53 ledger at the dish...In 34 affairs since, he is slashing .320/.399/.552 with 18 extra-base hits and raised his batting average .115 from .113 to .258.

LIVIN' LA VIDA LÓPEZ: 2B **Alejo López** has been a key part of Daytona's offense all season long...On Monday night, the 23-year-old had his Florida State League season-high 22-game on-base streak snapped...During the stretch from May 17-June 12, López accumulated a .305 average (25-82) with 12 runs scored, 5 doubles, 8 runs batted in, 7 walks, and a .376 OBP...The switch-hitter had an on-base streak of 14 games earlier in the campaign from April 9-24...During that run, López registered an impressive .357 average (20-56) with 9 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, 10 RBI, 2 walks, and 2 hit-by-pitches...The Phoenix, Ariz. resident slashed .357/.400/.518 with a .918 OPS in that span...López surpassed teammate SS **José García** (20), as well as Tampa's **Diego Castillo** and Dunedin's **Cullen Large** for the longest on-base streak in the FSL this year.

THE STARTING LINE: After a rough start to May, Daytona's rotation turned a corner in the final week-plus of the month and carried it into June...Over the last 29 games, the Tortugas' starting pitchers have accumulated just a 5-10 record, but maintain a sparkling 2.66 ERA (45 ER in 152.0 IP)...During that span, Daytona's starters have accrued 137 hits allowed, 134 strikeouts and just 30 walks...The Tortugas hold a 16-13 clip during those 29 games...The run has also featured a four-game stretch (May 22-25) where Daytona starters did not issue an earned run...The Tortugas went just 2-2 in those games, but tallied 23 straight frames without yielding an ERA-increasing tally...Daytona has also posted 10 quality starts during the stretch...Prior to this recent collection of starts, the 'Tugas starting staff had gone 4-5 with a 5.58 ERA (37 ER in 59.2 IP), 78 hits allowed, 13 walks, and 53 strikeouts in 13 games.

NOT SO FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Tortugas have put up better results in visiting ballparks than in their own in 2019...Entering Wednesday, Daytona holds a 19-11 mark in games played in opposing stadiums...In affairs held at Jackie Robinson Ballpark, the Tortugas record drops to 17-20...In contests played as the road team, Daytona has a .258 team batting average (299-1158) with 143 runs scored (4.3/g), 75 extra-base hits (2.3/g), 13 home runs (0.4/g), as well as 95 walks (2.9/g)...At home, the Tortugas average dips by 27 points down to .231 (253-1096)...Additionally, the team has scored 129 runs (3.79/g), 83 extra-base hits (2.4/g), 20 home runs (0.6/g), and 94 walks (2.8/g)...On the mound, Daytona's team ERA is slightly better in their own ballpark (3.41), as opposed to visiting parks (3.57)...3B **Jonathan India** has been better on the road this season, too...The 22-year-old holds a .288 clip (34-118) with 18 runs scored, 10 extra-base knocks, 3 homers, and 9 RBI in 29 road games...At home, India is batting .233 (27-116) with 19 runs scored, 10 extra-base hits, 5 home runs, and 15 RBI in 31 games...C **Hendrik Clementina** has also thrived away from Daytona Beach...Entering Wednesday, he holds a .256 mark (22-86) with 3 homers and 12 RBI in 21 games on the road...At home, he is batting just .191 (18-94) with 2 long balls and 8 RBI in 27 affairs...OF **Andy Sugilio**'s batting average splits are also quite different...The 22-year-old is hitting .333 (38-114) away from The Jack and .257 (26-101) within its confines.

BOYS GO TO JUPITER: The Tortugas had five players selected to the Florida State League All-Star Game, which was held this past Saturday at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium in Jupiter...C **Hendrik Clementina** (0-1), 3B **Jonathan India** (0-2, 2nd), 2B **Alejo Lopez** (0-2, SO: 7th), LHP **Packy Naughton** (DNP), and RHP **Ryan Nutof** (DNP) were the honorees...A sixth was added after the initial release, as OF **Andy Sugilio** (0-2, SO) will replace Lake-land's **Luke Burch**...RHP **Julo Pinto** (1.0 IP) was added as a seventh player, replacing Nutof who was promoted to Double-A...Daytona was tied with the Clearwater Threshers for the most players represented on the North Division squad (7)...The Fort Myers Miracle had the most players chosen to the contest with 8...India, Lopez, Nutof, Pinto, and Sugilio were selected as Mid-Season All-Stars for the first time in their careers...India is in his 2nd pro season, Lopez is in his 5th, Nutof his 3rd, Sugilio his 6th, and Pinto his 7th...Naughton had previously been chosen as a Mid-Season All-Star with Rookie Billings in the Pioneer League in 2017...Clementina made the Pioneer League Mid-Season All-Star squad in 2017 with Rookie Ogden and then again in the Midwest League with Low-A Dayton in 2018...Last season, the Tortugas had 8 players chosen to the contest: RHPs **Ryan Hendrix**, **Joel Kuhnel**, and **Tony Santillan**, as well as C **Tyler Stephenson**, 2B **Brantley Bell**, 3B **Mitch Nay**, and OFs **T.J. Friedl** and **Taylor Trammell**.

Surrendered four runs on five hits in 5.2 innings...Did not walk a batter and tied a season-high with seven strikeouts...Threw a season-worst two wild pitches...Issued a two-run home run to C **Rodolfo Durán** in the top of the fourth...Tossed 84 pitches and 59 strikes (70.2%)...Exited with a runner at third and two outs in the top of the sixth inning and Daytona trailing, 3-2... Relieved by RHP **Diomar López**...Bequeathed runner scored...Threshers went on to win, 8-3.
