JUST MISSING A WIN WEDNESDAY: The Riders were four outs away from victory Wednesday night before Stephen Wrenn hit a go-ahead, three-run homer in the bottom of the eighth to help the Hooks to a 4-2 win. Frisco grabbed a 2-1 lead in the sixth to back starter Brett Martin, who allowed just one run on seven hits in a season-best $52 / 3$ innings.

OH SO CLOSE: Wednesday's loss to Corpus Christi marked the sixth time this year that the Riders have lost when leading after seven innings (14-6).

NO PENA, NO GAIN: Righty Richelson Pena makes the start tonight, looking to continue his recent surge.

- $\quad$ Pena enters play as the league's leader in ERA (2.68).
- He comes off his second-career complete game last Thursday vs. Northwest Arkansas.
- In his last four starts, he's 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA after going 1-3 with a 4.21 mark in his first five outings.
- The righty hasn't allowed a run in his last 15 innings, the team's second-longest streak this season (reliever Brady Feigl never allowed a run in his $161 / 3$ innings of work with the Riders to start the year).

NOT A BAD TIME TO BE NAMED MICHAEL: Both guys named Michael on the roster - Michael De Leon and Michael
$\mathbf{O}^{\prime}$ Neill - are enjoying great seasons at the plate.

- De Leon: Has hits in 22 of his last 26 games (.305) to raise his average from . 223 to . 265 . He has already tied his 2017 totals in home runs (2) and three-hit games (3) and is tied for the team lead in doubles (12) after hitting just 16 all of last year.
- O'Neill: Currently on a nine-game hitting streak and is batting .367 with six homers in his last 12 games. Leads the team in home runs (9) and stolen bases (13), while ranking tied atop the doubles leaderboard (12).

YES, YOU'RE READING THE BOX SCORE CORRECTLY: A night after coming out of the bullpen, James Jones started at designated hitter last night and went 1 -for-2 with a walk, stolen base and run.

- Last night's appearance in the lineup was Jones' first since suiting up for Triple-A Round Rock July 10, 2016.
- Jones spent his first seven professional seasons as an outfielder in the Mariners organization (including big league time in 2014 and 2015) before getting traded to Texas in November of 2015 and making the switch to the mound halfway through 2016.
- The lefty is one of three former Major League outfielders in the Rangers organization who are also pitching now, joining Anthony Gose and Brett Eibner.

HUNTING FOR HOMERS: Former Riders outfielder Hunter Cole was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock Tuesday and is off to a roaring start with the Express, starting his time in Triple-A 5-for-9 with three home runs.

- Cole led the Riders in all three triple slash categories (.330/.412/.515) in addition to triples (2), RBIs (28) and walks (29).
- His .340 average ranks as the best in the Rangers farm system.
- Both the average and the OBP were fifth-best in the Texas League at the time of promotion.
- Cole had 23 multi-hit games in his 53 outings with the Riders, including a four-hit game last Friday.
