TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game series against the Biloxi Shuckers on Friday night at Trust mark Park trying to stop a season-high six-game losing streak. The Magnolia State rivals will meet 21 total times this season with one more meeting coming at MGM Park, Aug. 23-27.

MISSISSIPPI Branes

- M All-time the M-Braves are 48-52 against the Shuckers and 24-24 in games played at Trustmark Park. The M-Braves are 4-7 against Biloxi this season, including 1-5 in Pearl.
- DAVIDSON LEADS LEAGUE IN ERA: LHP Tucker Davidson saw his string of no earned runs end at 16.2 innings on Sunday, but the 23-year-old still leads the league and is 3rd in Double-A baseball with a 2.00 ERA. He also ranks among the league leaders in strikeouts (85, T-6th), opponents' batting average (.217, 5th). and WHIP (1.24, 11th).
- LAST TIME OUT: In front of a season-high crowd of 5,756 the M-Braves dropped their fourth-straight one-run game, 4-3, in 10 innings to the Shuckers in the series opener on Thursday night. The loss dropped the Braves to 8-7 all-time and 7-4 at home on the fourth of July. Mississippi erased a 3-0 deficit by scoring two runs in the eighth and a run in the ninth to tie the game, before falling in extras. 3B **Riley Unroe** was 3-for-4 with a run scored and game tying RBI in the ninth, while CF **Drew Waters** was 2-for-4 and RF **Tyler Neslony** was 2-for-5. Relievers **Claudio Custodio** and **Jason Hursh** combined to give up no earned runs over the final 6.0 innings.
- LEADING DOUBLE-A BASEBALL IN STRIKEOUTS: Atlanta Braves No. 3 overall prospect RHP Ian Anderson leads the Southern League, Double-A baseball and is T-4th in all of MiLB with 113 strikeouts over 17 starts. He is averaging 11.6 SO/9 IP. The New York native and 3rd overall pick in 2016 leads the league in opponents' AVG (.200), is 8th in IP (86.2), T-5th in wins (6), 8th in ERA (2.91) and 10th in WHIP (1.22)
- ANDERSON AND PACHE TO THE FUTURES GAME: RHP Ian Anderson and OF Cristian Pache were named to the 2019 All-Star Futures Game on Friday for the game that will be played on Sunday, July 7 at Progressive Field in Cleveland. The duo will represent the Atlanta Braves organization on the NL squad. MLB Network will exclusively televise and MLB.com will live stream the Futures Game at 6:00 pm CT, with Greg Amsinger, Harold Reynolds, Heidi Watney and MLB Pipeline's Jim Callis on the call live from Progressive Field.
- 100 HITS AND COUNTING FOR H2O: OF Drew Waters became the first player in the Southern League and Double-A baseball to the 100-hit mark in 2019 on June 30. Waters is on pace for 179 hits this season which would which blow past the M-Braves record of 148 set by Ernesto Mejia in 2011 and Dustin Peterson in 2016.
- M Waters leads all of Double-A baseball with 107 hits (next closest with 93, also T-5th in MiLB), 167 total bases, 27 doubles and tied with **Cristian Pache** with 41 extra-base hits. Waters leads the league in seven categories, AVG (.326), hits (107), doubles (27), triples (9), XBH, (T-1st, 41), TB (167) and runs (49). He ranks 3rd in OPS (.882) and 7th in slugging (.509).
- WATERS' SOUTHERN LEAGUE BEST STREAKS END JUNE 27: Waters went hitless during the Thursday, June 27 doubleheader against Jackson, ending his 30-game on-base streak that began on May 23, batting .388 (45-for-116) with 10 doubles, six triples, two home runs, 13 RBI, 21 runs, seven walks and .437 OBP. Waters has extended his streak 14 times during his first at-bat. It also ended the 18-game hitting streak that began on June 4, batting .417 (30-for-72) with eight doubles, two triples, two home runs, nine RBI, 12 runs, four walks and a .462 OBP. The streaks were the longest this season in the Southern League and on-base streak was third-longest in club history. The M-Braves record for on-base streak was 40 games set by Cristian Bethencourt in 2013.
- THE ATLANTA BRAVES TOP PROSPECT: OF Cristian Pache ranks among the Southern League in 11 different offensive categories: AVG (.297, 8th), hits (90, 3rd), doubles (24, 2nd), triples (6, T-3rd), XBH (41, T-1st), TB (159, 2nd), slugging (.525, 4th), OPS (.881, 5th), HR (11, T-7th), runs (44, T-3rd) and RBI (48, 3rd) Pache finished June batting .295 with eight doubles, a triple, seven home runs, 24 RBI, 10 walks and .370 OBP.
- CASTEEL CLEANING UP: 28-year-old 1B Ryan Casteel has found a home in the cleanup spot and leads the club and ranks 4th in the league with 14 home runs His three-homer game on July 3 was the first in M-Braves history. He ranks among the league leaders in slugging (.534, 2nd), OPS (.902, 2nd), AVG (.297, 7th), HR (14, 4th), RBI (45, 7th), OBP (.368, 10th), XBH (27, 9th) and TB (124, 6th),
- RECORD SETTING 14-13 LOSS ON WEDNESDAY: The M-Braves tied a Southern League record with 13 ex-Tra-base hits on Wednesday night at Pensacola. The 20 combined extra-base hits and 75 total bases set a new league record. **Ryan Casteel** became the first M-Brave to record three home runs in one game while the team's five total home runs, combined nine home runs, 39 total bases, 13 extra-base hits, 20 combined extra-base hits and 36 combined hits all set new M-Braves records.
- HISTORY MADE ON FRIDAY, JUNE 28: Ian Anderson and Jeremy Walker's combined nine-inning no-hitter on Friday, June 28 vs. Jackson was the third no-hitter in team history. The last was a combined no-hitter from Julio Teheran and Tyrelle Harris on Aug. 2, 2010 vs. Mobile. The first, and only individual no-hitter came from the late Tommy Hanson on June 25, 2008, vs. Birmingham. Anderson's 14 strikeouts over 7.0 innings in the game matched Hanson's single-game team record set in the same game.
- MULLER TIME: LHP Kyle Muller became just the second Southern League pitcher and third in Double-A baseball to reach 100 strikeouts on July 4. Muller ranks 2nd in the league, behind Ian Anderson, with 100 strikeouts on the season, is 3rd in IP (89.0) and 3rd in opponents' batting average (.208).

#### **TODAY'S GAME**

- Atlanta's No. 18 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and Southern League All-Star, Tucker Davidson makes his 16th start of 2019 and third start against the Shuckers.
- vs. Biloxi: Davidson is 1-1 with a 2.45 ERA over two starts against the Shuckers this season, allowing three runs over 11.0 innings with five walks and 10 strikeouts. Davidson earned the win on June 24 at Biloxi by dealing 6.0 shutout innings in the 1-0 victory.
- Among the SL Leaders: Davidson leads the league and is 3rd in AA baseball with a 2.00 ERA, is 5th in opponents' batting average at .217 and is T-6th in strikeouts (85).

#### LAST TIME OUT

Davidson allowed a season-high five earned runs on seven hits over 3.2 innings this past Sunday in the series opening 7-5 loss at Pensacola. Davidson gave up all five runs in the fourth inning after posting 3.0 shutout innings to begin the game and increase his streak to 16.2 innings without allowing an earned run. He walked just one and struck out seven.
