- **TODAY'S GAME:** The M-Braves begin their final road trip of the 2019 season on Friday night with game one of a five-game series at Biloxi. The Braves are coming off a 4-7 homestand against Birmingham (2-3) and Pensacola (2-4). The club will close out the season with a five-game homestand against Chattanooga, Aug. 29-Sept. 2.
- M All-time the M-Braves are 50-55 vs. Biloxi since 2015, 6-10 in games played this season and 24-28 in games played at MGM Park. Tonight is the 17th of 21 meetings this season between the Magnolia State rivals.
- LAST TIME OUT: The M-Braves closed out their 11-game homestand in 10 days with a 3-1 victory over Pensaco-la on Thursday night at Trustmark Park. RHP Claudio Custodio helped the M-Braves stop the three-game skid with a career high 7.0 innings of two-hit baseball, striking out five and walking two. LF Connor Lien finished 1-for-3 with a triple and two RBI and SS Ray-Patrick Didder was 2-for-3 with a walk and stolen base.
- THE GOOD AND BAD OF IT: Despite a total overhaul of the pitching staff and 7-14 record this month, M-Braves hurlers lead the Southern League in August with a 2.67 ERA. Jackson is 2nd with a 3.22 ERA. The M-Braves at the plate are last in the league this month with a .202 batting average and averaging just 2.2 runs per game. Overall this season, M-Braves pitchers lead the league with a 3.14 ERA.
- BULLPEN BEASTS: The M-Braves bullpen has covered 85.1 innings over 21 games in August and posted a 2.05 ERA (20 ER), with 73 strikeouts complared to 39 walks. M-Braves starters have logged 96.2 innings this month, including six quality starts.
- ROSTER TURNOVER: Only 13 of the 24 players currently on the active roster were active on Aug. 4. OF Cristian Pache, OF Drew Waters, RHP Ian Anderson, LHP Tucker Davidson, RHP Ben Rowen, LHP Tyler Matzek and C Jonathan Morales were promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett. LHP Kyle Muller, INF C.J. Alexander and INF Daniel Lockhart have been placed on the Injured List and INF Luis Valenzuela was released and RHP Brandon White was transferred to High-A Floridá. Also, LHP Joey Wentz was traded to Detroit on July 31.
- PFEIFER TRANSFORMING HIS CAREER: LHP Phil Pfeifer is averaging 10.4 SO/9.0 IP this season between Mississippi and Florida and has 146 strikeouts in 27 games, 18 starts and 100.0 innings. In four starts since returning to Mississippi on Aug. 1, the Vanderbilt product has a 1.17 ERA (3 ER/23.0 IP), 29 strikeouts, six walks, .195 BAA and 0.96 WHIP.
- M: He has the most strikeouts of any pitcher in Minor League Baseball with 100.0 IP or less. He has logged double-digit strikeouts three times this season, including a career-high 17 strikeouts on July 18 at Palm Beach.
- THE SHUTOUT KING: RHP Nolan Kingham leads Minor League Baseball with three complete game shutouts this season and is T-2nd in Minor League Baseball in innings pitched, logging 151.1 between Low-A Rome, High-A Florida and Mississippi.
- THE FIRST 2019 DRAFT PICK IN DOUBLE-A: On Aug. 16, SS Braden Shewmake was promoted to Mississippi from Low-A Rome, Atlanta's second first-round pick (21st overall) in this past June's MLB draft. Shewmake is the first 2019 draft pick to reach Double-A for any club. in 51 games, the Texas A&M product was batting 318 (64-for-201) with 18 doubles, two triples, three home runs, 39 RBI, 11 stolen bases and 389 OBP over 51 games. Atlanta's firs selection was Baylor catcher Shea Langeliers at ninth overall. He is currently playing for Low-A Rome
- ANOTHER 25 SB SEASON FOR DIDDER: Aruba native INF/OF Ray-Patrick Didder has stolen 25 bases for a fourth-straight season and is 18-for-19 in SB opportunities in 48 games during the second-half of the season with a .385 OBP, six doubles, home run, eight RBI and 21 walks. He now ranks 5th in the league with 24 stolen bases and 2nd in HBP (15). He has been HBP 114 times in his career and 102 times since the 2015 season.
- CASTEEL CLEANING UP: 28-year-old 1B Ryan Casteel has found a home in the cleanup spot and leads the club and ranks 3rd in the league with 19 home runs and three multi-homer games. His three-homer game on July 3 was the first in M-Braves history. He ranks among the league leaders in HR (19, 3rd), RBI (65, 4th), slugging (.468, 6th), OPS (.801, 9th), XBH (39, T-8th) and TB (177, 8th). Casteel has already moved into 7th place on the M-Braves all-time home run list and with one more home run would become just the second M-Brave to record 20 homers in a season, joining Ernesto Mejia (26) who did it in 2011.
- THREE MILLION FANS: The M-Braves celebrated the 3 millionth fan for Braves baseball at Trustmark Park on Aug. 14. Clinton, MS native Matt Baker (and son Wyatt attending his first game) was the 3 millionth fan and was given a prize pack that included 2020 M-Braves Season Tickets and 2020 Atlanta Braves tickets.
- HISTORY MADE ON JUNE 28: Ian Anderson and Jeremy Walker's combined nine-inning no-hitter on Friday, June 28 vs. Jackson was the third no-hitter in team history. The last was a combined no-hitter from Julio Teheran and Tyrelle Harris on Aug. 2, 2010 vs. Mobile. The first, and only indival no-hitter came from the late Tommy Hanson on June 25, 2008, vs. Birmingham. Anderson's 14 strikeouts over 7.0 innings in the game matched Hanson's single-game team record set in the same game.
- MADE IN MISSISSIPPI: OF Travis Demeritte made his MLB debut for the Detroit Tigers on August 2 at Texas becoming with 146th M-Braves alum to move to make their Major League debut. LHP Jeremy Walker 7/26/19, RHP Huascar Ynoa (6/16/19), OF Austin Riley (5/15/19), C Alex Jackson (4/7/19) and RHP Jacob Webb (4/16/19) have all made MLB debuts this season.
- FIVE ATL TOP 30 PROSPECTS ON THE ACTIVE ROSTER: The M-Braves remain one of the most talented teams in Minor League Baseball with seven of the Atlanta Braves top 30 prospects on the roster. LHP Kyle Muller (7, IL), C William Contreras (8), INF Braden Shewmake (9), OF Greyson Jenista (11), RHP Jasseel De La Cruz (14), OF Trey Harris (18) and INF C.J. Alexander (19, IL).

- Connor Johnstone makes his 27th appearance and sixth start for the M-Braves this season. This is Johnstone's fourth-straight start after joining the rotation on Aug. 7. He made two previous spot starts on April 18 at Chattanooga and June 27 vs.
- vs. Biloxi: In four relief outings this season, Johnstone has posted no record and a 1.13 ERA, allowing just one run over 8.0 innings with seven strikeouts and two

The right-hander suffered his second-straight loss on the mound, giving up four runs on six hits. matching a season and career high with six strikeouts, compared to a season-high three walks.

- Opened the 2019 season with Triple-A Gwinnett going 1-0 with a 6.75 ERA (5 ER/6.2 IP), two walks and two strikeouts over four relief apperances.

- Placed on Mississippi's roster on April 18 from Triple-A Gwinnett. (RHP Jason Creasy to Gwinnett). was promoted back to Gwinnett on June 13 and returned to Mississippi on June 21.
